Located on the east side of the Johnson School Road, about one-fourth mile from the intersection of that road with the Hartford-Livermore Road (Highway 136). Copied by Jerry Long, Owensboro, Ky., on 30 April 1988. Mr. Harry D. Tinsley, of No Creek, Ohio County, Ky., graciously allowed a comparison with a listing he made of the cemetery in 1950, in order to determine if any mistakes were made. Eighteen differences between the two listings were found and on 21 May 1988 these monuments were rechecked to see if a correct reading could be determined.

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Addenda to Carson Cemetery

A monument that is found in the Carson Cemetery was intentionally not included in the preceding listing of the cemetery. In recent years a monument was erected that lists the names of Pvt. Robert Carson (1758-1810) & his wife, Jane Robinson (1778-1836). This monument is a memorial marker and this pioneer couple was not actually buried here. The monument is also misleading because it contains several errors in dates. The monument was included in a former listing of the Carson Cemetery included in the book, Ohio County, Kentucky Cemeteries, Volume V (Ohio County Historical Society, 1994, p31). Due to this and several other errors I have submitted the listing on the preceding pages.

Robert Carson, son of William Carson & Eleanor McDuff, was born 20 July 1759 in Rowan County, North Carolina. He married Jane (Robinson) McMullen in Madison

County, KY on 22 July 1794. In the same county his brother, Lindsey Carson, married Jane's sister, Rebecca Carson on 11 February 1796. Near Richmond in Madison County on 24 December 1809 a son, Christopher Houston ("Kit") Carson was born to Lindsey & Rebecca. Robert Carson appears in the Madison County tax lists from 1790 through 1797. Robert then moved his family to Shelby County, KY, where he is found in the tax lists of 1799-1809 and the 1810 census. He died in Shelby County on 22 November 1810 and was buried there.



Robert Carson's wife, Jane Robinson, was the daughter of James & Elizabeth Robinson and was born about 1770 in Virginia. She married first James McMullen in Botetourt County, VA on 14 March 1788. About two years later they moved to Madison County, KY. He was killed in an Indian attack about 1792. Jane married a third time to John Gay Moore in Shelby County, KY on 18 July 1814. In 1828-1829 John G. & Jane and three of her Carson children (Lindsey Robinson, Sarah & Elizabeth) moved to Ohio County and settled in the No Creek community. John Gay Moore "of No Creek" wrote his will on 11 September 1835 and it was recorded in Ohio County in May 1836.

After the death of her husband, John G. Moore, Jane went to live with a son, James McMullen, Jr. (1792-1846), in Montgomery County, Indiana. Another son, William Carson, and a sister, Nancy Robinson Allen, were also residing there. Jane's great-grandson, James William Van Cleave (1845-1925) wrote a history of the family. A copy of his history of the Van Cleave, McMullen & Taylor families was placed in the Kentucky Historical Society Library, in Frankfort, KY by his nephew, Errett Van Cleave, in 1948. On page 10 of his section on the McMullen family he wrote: "James McMullen's [Jr.] mother, after the death of her third husband, came to live with him and died at his house." He goes on to relate several stories about the circumstances surrounding her death. He does not give the exact date of her death or place of burial. Her death occurred sometime during 1836-1846. Since her death was in Montgomery

County, IN it is logical to conclude that she was buried there. Due to the great distance from her former home in Ohio County, KY and the difficulty in traveling in those days it is highly improbable that she would not have been buried with her many relatives in Montgomery County.

The elder statesman of the Carson family in Ohio County, William Robinson Carson (1901-2001), believed that his great-great-grandmother, Jane Robinson Carson, died in Ohio County and was buried in the Carson Cemetery with her son, Lindsey Robinson Carson (1805-1876). William R. Carson had a gravestone for her and her husband, Robert Carson, erected in the Carson Cemetery about 1990. Mr. Carson had no knowledge of what his much older cousin, James William Van Cleave, had written many years previously and did not know of the existence of the family history until I told members of his family about it. Mr. Carson is further removed in time from the event and I have generally found that the closer a source is to an event the more likely it is to be true. Also the rich details of James William Van Cleave's account help to establish its validity. Due to the existence of the monument to Robert & Jane (Robinson) Carson in the Carson Cemetery many future family researchers will unfortunately assume that they were buried there.

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History of No Creek, Ohio County, Kentucky, by Harry D. Tinsley (Frankfort, KY: Roberts Printing Company, 1953, pp113-114):

CARSON CEMETERY

This historic cemetery, originally the Stevens burying ground, is located on the East side of the Johnson School Road, about one-fourth mile from the intersection of that road with the Hartford-Livermore Road, now Highway 136.

It became the Carson Cemetery in 1873 when Thomas Carson deeded .95 of an acre to the No Creek Church. The trustees named in the deed were Henry Stevens, J. C. Barnett, Jno. F. Wallace, A. P. Baird and B. L. Ward. Mr. Carson, a son of Lindsey and Elizabeth Carson, the latter a daughter of Thomas Stevens, owned the farm on which the cemetery was located.

The first burial was made there in August, 1807, just 146 years ago, when Susan, the six year old daughter of Thomas and Nancy Stevens, died on the third day of August. Mrs. Lydia Stevens, who was the head of the Stevens family when they came here in 1801, died June 7, 1829, in her 89th year and is also buried here.

Here also are buried three of her seven children as follows: Thomas (1771-1839); Charlotte (1778-1874), who married Higginson Belt and Henry (1784-1874) and her descendants to the seventh generation.

There are thirteen veterans of the War Between the States resting in the cemetery, a list of which is to be found elsewhere in this book.

A seven-generation group, with the sixth living, buried there includes Lydia Stevens, (1741-1829); her son, Henry Stevens, (1784-1874); his son Richard Stevens, (1808-1894); his son, Henry T. Stevens, (1831-1871); his son, William F. Stevens, (1861-1945); his daughter, Mrs. Ina (Stevens) Stevens, living; her children, Robert (1913-1915) and Pauline (1916-1919). Another seven-generation group includes Lydia Stevens; her

son, Henry; his daughter, Sarah A. (Talbot) Wallace, (1813-1892); her son, John F. Wallace, (1834-1906); his son, William C. Wallace, (1867-1940); his son, Omer T., living, and his daughter, Louise (1929-1944). And still another seven generation group includes Lydia Stevens, her son, Henry; his son, Richard; his son, John W., (1833-1863); his daughter, Hannah (L. F.) Bennett, (1863-1932); her son, Grover C. Bennett, (1884-1939); his children, Ruby (1908-08, age, 8 months) and Robert Lewis (1909-11).

A sixth-generation group there includes Lydia Stevens; her son, Henry; his daughter, Martha (Peter) Lindley (1821-1848); her daughter, Mary E. (James) Ward, (1842-1915); her son, Dillis E. Ward, (1866-1939) and his son, John W. (1895-1934). The latter was a tragic death.

A six generation group as traced through Thomas Stevens., include Lydia Stevens; her son, Thomas (1771-1839); his daughter, Elizabeth (Lindsey) Carson, (1805-1862); her son, Alex W. Carson, (1846-1921); his daughter, Emmer C. (John A.) Johnson, (1872-1933); her sons, Wm. Tedy, (1901-02) and Alex C. (1908-1928), who was killed in a car wreck. A six generation group also there, with the fifth living, includes Lydia Stevens; her son, Thomas; his daughter, Elizabeth Carson; her son, William A. Carson, (1833-1902); his son, W. K, Sr., (1875-living) and his son, Leland E. (1905-1939).

One of the five generation groups there includes Lydia Stevens; son, Henry; his daughter, Ellen (Morris) Barnett (1831-1911); her daughter, Emma (John S.) Bennett, (1851-1888) and her daughter, Eulah (J. S.) Taylor, (1883.1908), the last two being untimely deaths.

There have been more than 250 burials in this cemetery and most of them were descendants, either by blood or marriage, of Lydia Stevens, whose husband, Richard, died in Maryland before she and their children emigrated to Ohio County. A large proportion of those who rest in this cemetery bore the following family names: Stevens, Carson, Barnett, Bennett, Lindley, Chapman, Wallace, Ward,; Johnson, Shown, Edwards, Foster, Chamberlin, Williams, Lashbrook, Tower, Daman, Belt, Miller, Sullenger, and Hughes.
