

# Crawford Cemetery

## Breckinridge County, KY

On the north side of Highway 992 about 3 miles east of the Breckinridge-Hancock County line. On farm of Ed Campbell. From his home, a grey bedford stone, walk across open field. Cemetery sets in a clump of trees on the east edge of the field. Found 7 inscribed monuments. Cemetery is enclosed by 2 foot long rectangular stones. Copied 19 May 1980 by Jerry Long, Owensboro, KY.

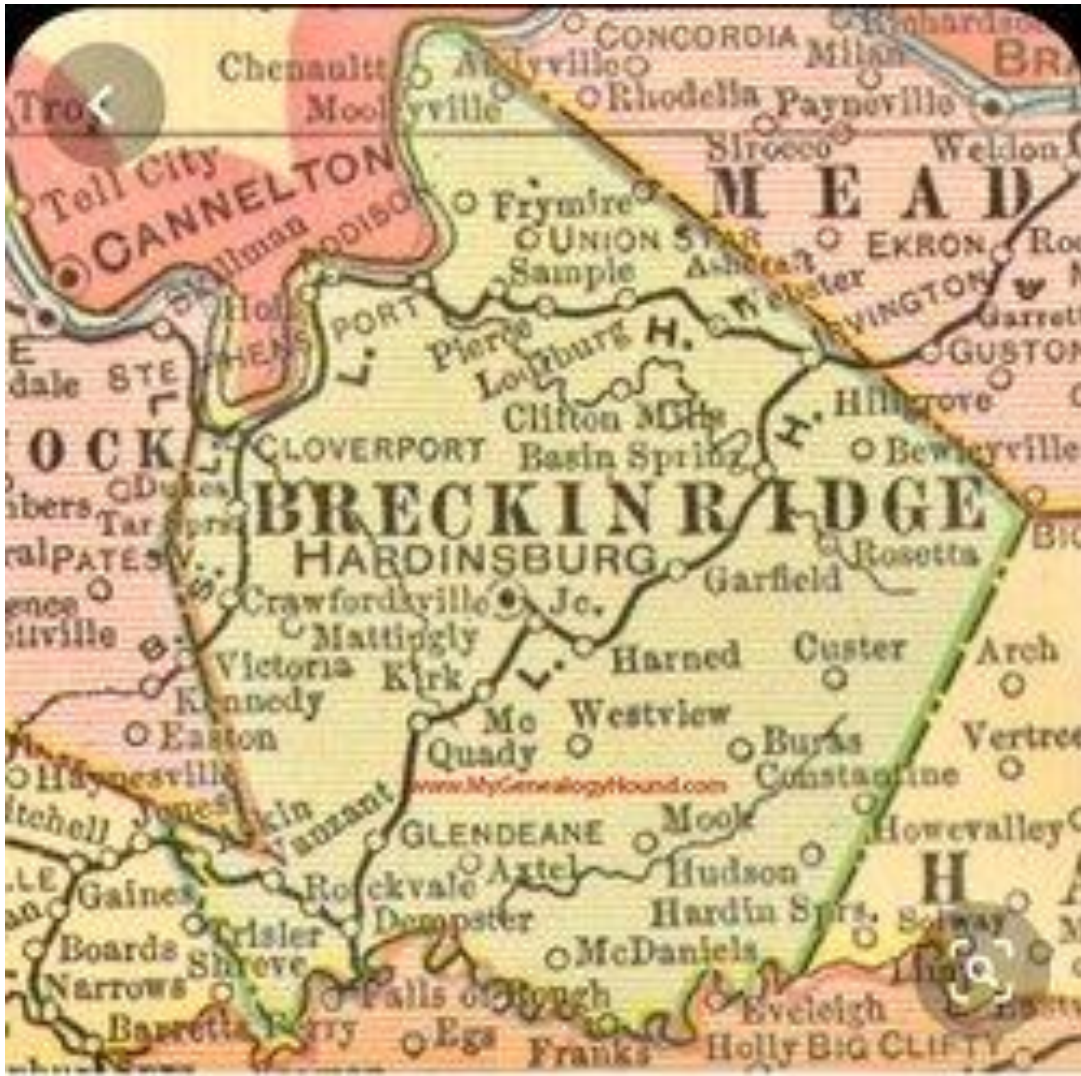

Samuel Crawford, Jr., son of Samuel Crawford & Janet / Jane Mason, was born 29 January 1781 Virginia and died 23 May 1824. He married Theodosia Earl Compton, 16 February 1806 Breckinridge County, KY. The daughter of Matthew Compton & Theodosia Earle she was born 29 January 1854. Samuel & Theodosia were the parents of:

- Daviess Earl Crawford, born 6 December 1806 Breckinridge County, KY; he was murdered by Riley Basinger & Marion Baker on 11 November 1862 in Breckinridge County, KY, where he kept a saloon at Clifton Mills; he died single and was buried with his parents in the Crawford Cemetery, Breckinridge County, KY.
- Cynthia E. Crawford, born 1808-1809 Breckinridge County, KY. She married William G. Boyd (14 October 1783 – 3 May 1863), 3 May 1848 Clifton Mills, Breckinridge County, KY; she died 1884 Breckinridge County, KY. William G. Boyd was buried in the Boyd Cemetery, Skillman Bottoms, Hancock County, KY.
- Eliza Jane Crawford, born 14 March 1811 Breckinridge County, KY; married John Fitzgerald, circa 1830. She died 27 August 1836 and was buried Crawford Cemetery, Breckinridge County, KY.
- Samuel C. Crawford, born 17 August 1815 Breckinridge County, KY; married Aly / Allie Ann Hodges, 5 April 1863 Breckinridge County, KY. He died 13 March 1893 Indianapolis, IN and was buried Crawford Cemetery, Breckinridge County, KY. His widow, Aly, married Lewis N. Howard, 8 November 1894 Marion County, IN. Samuel & Aly had two children – Daviess / Davis A. Crawford (1864-1939) and Ella May Crawford (1869-1899, wife of William Oliver Norris).
- Mary Angeline Crawford, born 21 November 1816 Breckinridge County, KY; died 22 July 1842 and was buried Crawford Cemetery, Breckinridge County, KY.
- Theodosia Elmina Crawford, born c1819 Breckinridge County, KY; married George Madison Younger (26 February 1819 – 25 December 1896). She died 11 July 1876 Hancock County, KY. Their children were – John Samuel (1840-1840), Mary Ann (1841-1859), Maria Jane (1844-1875, wife of Edwin Brashear), Daviess C. (1845-1924, wife Nannie B. Spencer), Claudius Clarendon (1847-1937, wife Martha Hamilton Jackson), Evaline (1855-1855) and Luella Elmina (1856-1859). George M. Younger was buried at the Cloverport Cemetery, Breckinridge County, KY; he married Lucy Mays (1843-1926), 27 January 1880 Hancock County, KY; they had one child, James Skillman Younger (1883-1956).
