The following is a subject index of the quarterly published by the Daviess County Historical Society. The quarterly (56 issues) was published by editor Lee A. Dew – from Volume 1, No. 1, January 1983 thru Volume XIV, No. 4, October 1996.

The first Daviess County Historical Society was organized on 12 March 1931 (see “County History Society Formed”, Owensboro Messenger, Owensboro, KY, Friday, 13 March 1931, p3). This venture was short lived. The last reference found in the Owensboro newspapers of any activity by the organization was the group’s meeting of 10 March 1932. A second Daviess County Historical Society was organized at their charter meeting on 26 March 1963. The society disbanded about 1999.
