

## Henry Richard Garrison (1849-1921)

Alfred Garrison was born about 1810 in North Carolina. He was the son of Garret Garrison, who was born about 1777 in North Carolina and who is listed in the 1850 census of Rhea County, Tenn. Alfred married Sarah Hutchins on 11 February 1830 Rutherford County, N.C., Sarah was also a native of North Carolina. By the time of the birth of their son, Henry Richard Garrison, in 1832 they were living in Tennessee. They were listed in the 1850 census of Jackson County, Tenn. And 1860 census of Putnam County, Tennessee:

During the decade of 1860-1867 Alfred Garrison left Tennessee and moved to Kentucky. About 1867 he settled in Butler County, Ky., near Sugar Grove. He first appears in the tax lists

of Butler County in 1867. He may have possibly been in Kentucky for a few years before going to Butler County. The family of Alexander Andrews, also of Tennessee arrived in Butler County about the same time as Alfred Garrison, and for several years immediately before had resided in Logan County, Ky. Alfred Garrison is listed in the 1870 census of Butler County, his household appeared as follows:

Alfred Garrison's and his wife, Sarah, were not found in the 1880 census and probably had died previously. On 16 March 1876 in Butter County, Ky. an Alfred Garrison married a B. A. Thompson. Witnesses on their marriage bond were Richard Garrison and his son-in-law, James Martin. Alfred Garrison was still living in Butler County when his daughter, Nancy, married in 1879.

Isaac H. Garrison, son of Alfred & Sarah (Hutchins) Garrison, was born about 1834. He appeared in the tax lists of Butler County, Ky. 1867-1870. He must have died during 1870, he last appeared in the Butler County tax records in that year and in the 1870 Butler County census his wife, Emeline and son, Curtis Polk (born about 1858 Tenn.) are shown living alone close to the residence of his father, Alfred Garrison.

Alfred Burton Garrison, son of Alfred & Sarah (Hutchins) Garrison, was born 6 October 1842 Tenn., married Martha E. Bullington, and died 14 December 1917 Butler County, Ky.; buried Cave Rock Cemetery, Butler County, Ky.

Martha Garrison, daughter of Alfred & Sarah (Hutchins) Garrison, was born 11 November 1846 Tenn., married James W. Martin on 24 July 1870 at the residence of her father in Butler County, Ky., and died 1 August 1922 Butler County, Ky., buried Sandy Creek Cemetery, Butler County, Ky.

Nancy E. Garrison, daughter of Alfred & Sarah (Hutchins) Garrison was born about 1853 Tenn., married Jeremiah Bolling 20 July 1879 Butler County, Ky. at the home of Alfred Garrison.

Elzira Butler Garrison, daughter of Alfred & Sarah (Hutchins) Garrison, was born 16 July 1856 Tenn., in Butler County, Ky. on 7 Dec. 1876 she married Thomas M. Willoughby; she married 2<sup>nd</sup> a Lykins; died 18 March 1943 Butler County, Ky., buried Sandy Creek Cemetery, Butler County, Ky.

Henry Richard Garrison, son of Alfred & Sarah (Hutchins) Garrison, was born in April 1849 in Tennessee. On his second marriage it was recorded that he was born in Ray County, Tenn., this was probably a misspelling of Rhea County, Tenn. He went by the name of Richard and was familiarly called by the nickname of "Dick". At the age of 21 he was first listed in the tax books of Butler County, Ky. He could not be located in the 1870 census of Butler County but was in that county's tax lists in that year,

Richard Garrison married Permelia Anna Andrews on 3 June 1869, They were married at the home of her father, Alexander Andrews, in Butler County, Ky. Permelia Anna Andrews was born 31 August 1843, to the marriage of Alexander Andrews & Sarah Catherine Gill. According to the marriage bond of her daughter, Rosa in 1908, Permelia was born in Jackson County, Tenn. (Ohio County, Ky. marriage book 20, page 200). Her parents were also natives of Tennessee, her father, Alexander Andrews, was born there about 1824. About 1860 her family left Tennessee and moved to Kentucky, where they resided in Logan County for a few years before making their home in Butler County, Ky. The household of Alexander Andrews appeared as follows in the 1870 census of Butler County:

For a time between 1880 & 1900 the family of Richard Garrison may, have left Ohio County. In 1884 their daughter, Rosa, was born in Warren County, Ky. and in the 1890 tax list of Ohio County H. R. Garrison was not listed. By 1893 his family had returned to Ohio County. Richard Garrison never purchased any land in Ohio County, in the 1900 census he was shown as renting a farm and in 1910 he was renting a house in or in the vicinity of McHenry, Ky. His occupation in 1880 and 1900 was listed as farmer and in 1910 he was listed as a laborer at odd jobs.

Permelia Anna Garrison died 6 November 1914 in Ohio County, Ky. Her death certificate is on file at the Ohio County Health Department in Hartford, Ky. The following was recorded on the records "Anna Garrison died 6 November 1914 at McHenry, married, born 31 August 1843 Tenn., age 71-2-5, father- \_\_Andrews, mother \_\_, buried Render, informant Jim Martin". No obituary for her appeared in the Hartford Herald newspaper.

Richard Garrison remarried on 18 February 1915 to Mrs. Mabel Culbertson. They were married at Simmons, a small coal town about a mile south of McHenry in Ohio County. On their marriage bond it was recorded that he was a resident of Render (a community about a mile north of McHenry), born in Ray [sic] County, Tenn., age 58, widowed,, father Alford Garrison, mother Sarah Hutchison (Ohio County marriage book 26, page 139). His wife was Mabel McDaniel and was born 30 April 1883 at Rosine in Ohio County to Thomas McDaniel and Charlotte Kuykendoll. She was the widow of Robert D. Culbertson, they had been married 7 December 1909 in Ohio County. This was her fourth marriage. She had two children by her prior marriages, a son, Clarence Bailey, and a daughter, Marie Culbertson, who married Charles Trail.

At the age of 72 Henry Richard Garrison died in Ohio County on 21 October 1921. His death reported he died of typhoid fever. No obituary for him was published in the Ohio County newspapers. He was buried beside his wife, Permelia, at the Render Memorial Cemetery in McHenry, they do not have any monuments. His widow, Mabel McDaniel Garrison, died 30 May 1943 at McHenry and was buried there in the Render Memorial Cemetery.

Henry Richard Garrison had eleven children. To him and Permelia Anna Andrews nine children were born, they were: Sarah L., Eliza A., Maria Elizabeth, Delia, James W., Harriet

Jennie, Rosa, William and another child died in infancy. To his marriage to Mabel McDaniel two children were born: Richard Thomas & Virgie Mae.

1. Sarah L. Garrison was born about 1870 and died after 1880.
2. Eliza A. Garrison was born about 1871. In the vital statistics of Butler County, Ky. it was recorded that she died on 4 April 1876 at the age of 4, was born in Ky., died of hemorrhage of brain, parents were R. & Permelia Garrison, parents were born Tennessee.
3. Maria Elizabeth (Lizzie) Garrison was born 21 June 1873 in Butler County, Ky. She married William Stanley Hodge. 19 July 1893 in Ohio County, Ky. At the time of the 1910 Ohio County census her children were: Cecil E., Martha A., Harry, Eddie C., Floyd, Addie M. and Ida. She died 15 June 1947 Odin, Marion County, Ill. Buried Peaceful Valley Cemetery, Odin, Ill.
4. Cordelia Frances Garrison was born 14 March 1875 Butler County, Ky. She married first T. B. Ross. 5 April 1894 in Ohio County, Ky. and second Thomas S. Gibbs 2 July 1908 at Hartford in Ohio County. She died 6 March 1965 Odin, Marion County, Ill., buried Peaceful Valley Cemetery, Odin, Ill.
5. James William (Jim) Garrison was born in August 1876 in Butler County, Ky. He married Annie Leon Basket (Bosket\_ 4 January 1899 at the home of Richard Garrison in Ohio County, Ky. On their marriage bond it was recorded that he was "born in Butler County, Ky., age 21, 1st marriage, a miner, resident of Ohio County, parents born in Tenn., bride was age 19, she and her parents were born in Ohio County, Ky." She was the daughter of Hiles Bosket and Elizabeth Ann Fulkerson and was born 18 January 1879. James Garrison worked in the coal mines around McHenry in Ohio County. James and Annie separated about 1913, he moved to Henderson County, Ky. where he worked in the mines at Baskett. On 1 November 1918 he died of influenza at Baskett, Ky., on his death certificate it was reported that he was age 42, a miner, divorced, was the son of Richard Garrison, he was buried in the Baskett Cemetery. About 1915 Annie Garrison moved to Owensboro, Ky. She and James Garrison were divorced in Daviess County, Ky. in 1916. In Owensboro on 26 September 1919 she married William Robert Zuik and on 16 December 1920 she married Homer Winkler. On both of her marriage bonds it was recorded that she was a widow, was born in Ohio County, Ky., and her parents were listed as Hiles and Bettie Ann Baskett. Annie Garrison Winkler died at the Owensboro - Daviess County Hospital on 21 June 1968 at the age of 69, she was buried at the Rose Hill Cemetery in Owensboro, James W. Garrison and Annie L. Bosket had seven children, all were born in Ohio County. Ky.: Elizabeth Lee (born 6 May 1899 Ohio County, Ky., married John Rennie Alvey, died 24 August 1972 Gary, Lake County, Ind.), George Abraham (born 8 April 1903, married Jessie F. Carter 7 June 1926 in

Owensboro, Ky, he died 14 September 1950 at the Owensboro-Daviess County Hospital and was buried at the Rose Hill Cemetery in Owensboro), William James (born 23 September 1904, married Lillian Carroll, Hazel Brandenburg Osborne and Blanche Powers, he died 1 May 1977 at the Owensboro-Daviess County Hospital and was buried at the Rose Hill Cemetery in Owensboro), John Raymond (born 31 October 1906, married Vera Wolf 27 November 1925 Owensboro), Daisy Gary (22 December 1930 Owensboro, Opal Saga 10 March 1934 Owensboro and Gertie (Renner) Smiley 14 July 1952 Owensboro, he died 30 September 1968 at the Owensboro-Daviess County Hospital and was buried at the Rose Hill Cemetery in Owensboro), a child born and died between 1901-1910), Mattie May (born 20 February 1911, her death certificate recorded that "Mattie May Garrison died 20 April 1914 at McHenry, born 2 June 1910 McHenry, age 3-10-18, parents James Garrison and Annie Basket, buried Render", in the Register of Kentucky Births her birth was recorded as 20 February 1911 and her name was given as Mattie Basket Garrison) and Richard (born 7 March 1913. In the death records at the Ohio County Health Department it was recorded that "Richard Garrison died 25 April 1914 at McHenry, age 1 yr. & 16 days, born McHenry, Ky. parents James Garrison and Annie Basket, buried Render".

6. Harriet "Jennie" Garrison was born 31 March 1879 in Butler County, Ky. In Ohio County, Ky. she married James M. Martin on 4 January 1899. She died 25 February 1963 Herrin, Williamson County, Ill.
7. Rosa Jane Garrison was born 8 February 1884, on her marriage record it was reported that she was born in Warren County, Ky. On 12 August 1908 in Ohio County, Ky. she married Phillip B. Fulkerson. She died 1 June 1967 Odin, Marion County, Ill.
8. William Garrison was born in January 1888. At the age of eighteen he died on 27 February 1906, he was not married. He was buried at the Render Memorial Cemetery in McHenry, Ohio County, Ky. On his monument it is written that he was a son of R.H. & A. Garrison, born 1888, died 1906.
9. One other child of Henry Richard Garrison and Permelia Anna Andrews died in infancy before 1900.
10. Richard Thomas Garrison, son of Richard Garrison and Mabel McDaniel, was born 27 May 1917 in Ohio County, Ky. He and Helen Abney were married at Beaver Dam in Ohio County on 22 August 1938. They resided in Louisville, Ky., where he died 3 June 1962. He was buried in the Sunnyside Cemetery in Beaver Dam, Ohio County, Ky.

11. Virgie Mae, daughter of Richard Garrison and Mabel McDaniel, was born 27 June 1920 in Ohio County, Ky. She married James, William Calloway 19 April 1939 in Beaver Dam, Ohio County, Ky. In 1987 she was a resident of Louisville, Ky. Virgie married Oscola Wilhite 14 September 1982 at Hartford, Ohio County, Ky. Her marriage license recorded - Bride age 62, widowed, her second marriage, born 19 June 1920 McHenry, Ky., parents Richard Garrison & Mabel McDaniel,, residence Beaver Dam, Ky, James W. Galloway and Virgie Garrison had two sons: Richard Emmett Galloway, who is living Louisville, Ky., and Jimmy Bruce Galloway, who is living Big Springs, Ky.
