Additional notes by Jerry Long:

John Solomon Henry Kigel, a native of Ohio County, KY, was the son of Solomon Kigel & Susan Spence. Solomon Kigel, son of Jacob, was born near Philadelphia, PA in August 1801. In Ohio County, KY Solomon married Susan Spence, daughter of John, in 1839. Shortly after John S. H. Kigel's birth in 1840 his mother died. He moved to Owensboro, with his father in 1842; his father died there on 20 August 1856. John S. H. Kigel in 1867 built the first residence and started the first store at Newville, Daviess County, KY. He later operated mercantile stores at Glenville, where he located in 1877, and Owensboro, where he moved to in 1892.

Ann Boyd, first wife of John S. H. Kigel, was born in Daviess County, KY to the marriage of William Boyd & Elizabeth Fitts; Ann was buried at the Greenbrier Baptist Church, in Daviess County, KY. Jennie Shackelford, second wife of John S. H. Kigel, was the daughter of James Shackelford & Amelia Settle, she was also buried at Greenbrier. Mattie Cocke, third wife of John S. H. Kigel, was the daughter of Stephen Cooke & Scythia Foxworthy. She was buried beside her husband at Elmwood Cemetery in Owensboro, Daviess County, KY. John S. H. Kigel died at his home in Owensboro.

According to his obituary in the 2 March 1928 issue of the Owensboro Messenger, he was survived by: son, Henry Kigel, of Louisville, KY; two daughters, Mrs. T. F. Lee & Miss Clyde Kigel, both of Owensboro; and seven grandchildren - J. W. Kigel of Louisville, Mrs. H. C. Cox of Glenville, KY, Evan Lee of Madisonville, KY, Enda Lee & Cora Lee, of Richmond, KY, Mrs. Bruce Harrison of Bowling Green, KY, and Mrs. W. C. Lee of Fort Thomas, KY.
