She is the daughter of Ernest Edward Mickel (1902-1979) & Zelma Lambert, granddaughter of Oliver Ernest Mickel (1879-1964) & Celia Catherine Snyder, and great-granddaughter of Conrad Mickel (1838-1918) & Lutitia C. Hale (1842-1926).

Marriages

Conrad Mickel and Luticia C. Hale was married on the 26th day of May 1861.
Robert T. Mickel & Rosa Gardner were married at the residence of the brides parents on Monday, Jan. the 28th 1895 at 12 o'clock. Rev. R. T. Bruner officiated. Waiters Wallace Stewart, Miss Kate Hunter and Willie Mickel & Miss Ella Stewart.

Conrad Mickel was born on the 5th day of December 1838.
Luticia C. Mickel was born on the 25th day of August 1842.
Mary E. Mickel was born on Friday the 16th day of May at 11 o'clock in the evening 1862.
Sarah C. Mickel was born on February Sunday the 14th at 9 o'clock in the morning 1864.
George H. Mickel was born Wednesday the 7th day of March at 1 o'clock in the morning 1866.
Robert T. Mickel was born on Saturday the 7th day of March at 1 o'clock in the evening 1868.
William F. Mickel was born on Tuesday the 26th day of July at 4 o'clock in the morning 1870.
Charles F. Mickel was born on Friday the 27th day of September at 12 o'clock in the evening 1872.
Luticia Ann Mickel was born on Tuesday the 22nd day of September at 3 o'clock in the morning 1874.
Magge L. Mickel was born on Monday the 1st day of November at 3 o'clock in the evening 1875.
Theaphelus W. Mickel was born on Wednesday the 14th day of November at 9 o'clock in the evening 1877.
Oliver E. Mickel was born on Thursday the 17th day of April at 4 o'clock in the morning 1879.
Edward Arthur Mickel was born on Wednesday August the 25th at 12 o'clock in the evening 1881.
Rosa Mickel was born March the 17th 1870.
Robert T. Mickel was born March the 7th 1868.
Chleo Hudson Mickel their daughter was born January the 7th 1896 Wednesday morning at 4 o'clock.

Deaths

Luticia Ann Mickel died October the 5th 1874.

Theaphelas Walter Mickel died the 15th day of November 1877.

Additional notes by Jerry Long:

Conrad Mickel was a native of Selters, Hesse Darmstadt, Germany. He arrived in the US at the port of New Orleans on 18 June 1852. On board the ship Uhland were the following Mickel family members – Justus (age 49), Heinrich (75), Maria (24), Catharine (21), Elisabeth (18), Conrad (12), Margaretha (9) & Doreta (7). An older brother, Henry, had already made the voyage. His parents, Johann Jost Mickel & Anna Maria Lenz, were married on 19 July 1829 at Selters. His father was born about 1803 and died in Hancock County, KY in July 1858. He was the son of Johann Heinrich Mickel (6 Apr 1777 Selters -) & Ann Dorothea Filsinger (6 Feb 1777 Selters – 5 Feb 1829 Selters), who were married at Selters on 24 April 1798. Conrad's great-grandparents were Johann Heinrich Mickel & Anna Elisabetha Weisenbok (married 23 April 1776 Selters) and Johann Philip Filsinger & Anna Konig (married 27 March 1767 Selters). Conrad's mother was the daughter of Johann Friedrich Lenz & Margaretha Elisabetha Kraft. A brother, Henry (28 April 1835- 13 April 1888), and a sister, Mary (8 Jan 1827- 9 Nov 1875, wife of George Fuchs) are buried in the same cemetery in Hancock County as Conrad. His sister, Elizabeth (5 March 1833 – 19 Nov 1902, wife of George A. Sites), is buried at Elmwood Cemetery in Owensboro, KY. Another sister, Dora (17 May 1844 -) married Jacob Hilf and lived in Meade County, KY. Marriages for his other two sisters, Catharine (10 Jan 1831 -) & Margaretha (27 April 1842 -) could not be located in Hancock County or the surrounding counties.

In Hancock County, KY in 1861 Conrad married Lutitia C. Hale (the spelling of her first name is the way it appears on her gravestone). She was a sister of this compilers' 2nd great-grandmother, Armina Hale Young. Born in Hancock County they were daughters of William Hale, Jr. & Ruth Elmina Bruner and granddaughters of William Hale & Catherine Snider and George Washington Bruner & Mary Davis.

Conrad and Lutitia Mickel died in Hancock County, KY and were buried there in the Blackford Baptist Church Cemetery. His death occurred on 18 April 1918 and hers' on 15 May 1926. Eleven children were born to them; all were born in Hancock County. They were: Mary Elmira (1862-1942, wife of Thomas William Glover), Sarah Catherine (1864-1935, wife of John Thomas Brandle), George Henry (1866-1949, married Nan B. Gibbs & Bessie Lee Adams), Robert Titus (1868-1948, married Rosa Gardner), William Franklin (1870-1956, married Ora Katherine Harrison & Louise Saalwaechter), Charles Frank (1872-1954, married Luella Curry), Luticia Ann (1874-1874), Margaret Luvenia (1875-1937, wife of Henry William Schafer), Theaphelus Walter (1877-1877), Oliver Ernest (1879-1964, married Celia Catherine Snyder) and Arthur Edward (1881-1951, married Margaret F. Stinnet).
