## **PAPERS OF BOBBIE H. O'BRIEN**

Following the death of Bobbie O'Brien, member of WCK:FRA, avid family researcher, and part time professional researcher, of Ohio County, Kentucky, members of her family donated her genealogical files, excepting those directly relating to her family, to West-Central Family Research Association. The original material is located in our library/workroom at 722 Harvard Drive.

In order to make this material more accessible to area researchers, the WCK:FRA board authorized Jerry Long (presently vice-president and chair of genealogical records committee) to photocopy, organize and bind selected portions of her files. Material not copied is already readily available in some other form.

The PAPERS OF BOBBIE H. O'BRIEN were organized and grouped by the main surnames involved. These surname groupings appear in alphabetical order in this TEN VOLUME, ca 2500 page, set, with a colored title sheet preceding each surname group. An index to the PAPERS has been prepared with the main surname group underlined and a cross-index added for surnames within the sections with a significant amount of data. Though not an absolutely every name index, this 28 page cross-index provides the key to the family data here.

The list of SURNAMES which are cross-indexed would be even longer. For example: information on the BLACK surname (not a SECTION) is found in three sections - BARNARD, DUKE and SWEAZEY., and more information on the CLARK surname (which is a SECTION) can be found in the LANGLEY, MANSFIELD, and RICHARDS SECTIONS.

This TEN-VOLUME SET is bound in hard cover and on the shelves in the KENTUCKY ROOM, Owensboro-Daviess County Library. It is not available for sale, and this is the only copy. We should all say a special "Thank You!" to Jerry Long for his fine work, and to WCK:FRA for bearing the expense of this project!

#### OBITUARIES

BOBBIE HAMILTON O'BRIEN, 47, died tragically in a fire at her home in Hartford, Kentucky on April 28, 1982. She was born in Calhoun County, Mississippi but was a long time resident of Kentucky. She was actively engaged in family and professional genealogical research and was a member of WCK:FRA Ohio Co. Historical Society, Kentucky Historical Society, Ancestral Trails Historical Society and Nelson County Historical Society. She was the author of John Mayberry Easley - His Ancestors and Descendants, and more recently of the heavily annotated volume, OHIO COUNTY, KENTUCKY 1860 CENSUS. Her knowledge of Ohio and adjoining counties families was extensive and other books were in the final stages of preparation. Fortunately, her extensive collection of genealogical notes and card file was not damaged in the fire. It is hoped that WCK:FRA can bring some of this material into publication in her memory.

She is survived by her husband, John, and by two daughters by her first marriage Mrs. Leigh Anne Pasley of Memphis, TN and Miss Nora Elizabeth Hagerman, of New Albany, Mississippi, by a granddaughter, Sarah Elizabeth Pasley, by her mother and two sisters. Our sympathy to all of her family.

Additional notes by Jerry Long:

For this series, Papers of Bobbie H. O'Brien, copies of the originals were made and organized by Jerry Long, vice-president of WCK:FRA. All of Mrs. O'Brien's files were duplicated except the following:

1. Papers compiled by Marcus Whitler on his ancestral families (Whitler, Crow, Huff, Hale, Keown, etc.). Since the Owensboro library already possesses copies of the Whitler papers it was decided not to duplicate them.
2. Clippings from the Ohio County and Owensboro, KY newspapers.
3. And several file drawers of 3 x 5 index cards with various abstracted records alphabetized by the surname. The majority of these are abstracts of Ohio County, KY records (such as census, marriages, obituaries...) that are available at the Ohio County Courthouse and/or the libraries in Hartford and Owensboro.

In the front of Volume I of the Papers of Bobbie H. O'Brien there is a section on Bobbie O'Brien that has some information on Mrs. O'Brien and her family. This is followed by a section entitled "Ohio County Records". It contains several letters that have informative comments about some general records of Ohio County. The West-Central Kentucky Family Research Association, a long time genealogy society, in Owensboro, KY no longer exists. The WCK:FRA collection, including the original files of Bobbie O'Brien are housed at the McLean County History Museum and Regional Family Research Center in Calhoun, KY.

Bobbie Evelyn Hamilton was born 9 December 1934 Calhoun County, MS. She was the daughter of Robert Lee Hamilton and Evelyn Pauline Barker. She married 1<sup>st</sup> Robert Lee Hagerman, 11 July 1953 Tupelo, MS and 2<sup>nd</sup> John L. O'Brien. She died in trailer fire in Hartford, Ohio County, KY on 28 April 1982.

She was a graduate of Calhoun City High School, Calhoun County, Mississippi and attended Western Kentucky University, Bowling Green, Kentucky where she majored in Elementary Education and English. She was a member of the Ohio County Historical Society, West-Central Kentucky Family Research Association, Kentucky Historical Society, Nelson County Historical Society and a charter member of the Ancestral Trails Historical Society.

She was a professional genealogist. She was the author of two books: John Mayberry Easley His Ancestors and Descendants, 1818-1978 (McDowell Publications, Hartford, KY, 1978) and Ohio County, Kentucky 1860 Census: An Indepth Study of the Census and Marriage Records of Ohio County (Cook & McDowell Publications, Owensboro, KY, 1981). She spent two years researching and compiling the latter standard reference work. She annotated the actual census reports with cross references to the 1850 census, marriages and other original data.

I (Jerry Long) began to research my family history in 1979. On 11 February 1980 I met Bobbie O'Brien while researching at the Ohio County Public Library in Hartford, KY. She knew about my great-great-grandfather, Benjamin F. Long, a Civil War veteran. She told me that local artist, Mary Jo White, had recently completed a painting ("Humble Valley Home") of his home at Jingo in Ohio County, KY. After over 40 years of doing family research this still ranks as one

of my biggest genealogical thrills. On 30 April 1980 I visited Mrs. O'Brien at her home in Hartford and she gave me many leads and contacts on my Ohio County lineage.

In compiling the Papers of Bobbie H. O'Brien I organized Mrs. O'Brien's original files alphabetically by the main surname she was doing research on. Her papers were arranged into the following 10 volumes: Vol. 1 – "A-B"; Vol. 2 – "C"; Vol. 3 – "Da-De"; Vol. 4 – "Do-Du"; Vol. 5 – "E-F"; Vol. 6 – "G-H"; Vol. 7 – "J-L"; Vol. 8 – "M"; Vol. 9 – "O-R"; & Vol. 10 – "S-W". The 10-volume set of the Papers of Bobbie H. O'Brien, was placed in the family histories section of the Kentucky Room at the Daviess County Public Library, Owensboro, KY (Library catalog # KR G O'Bri.). The following is a partial cross index of major surnames appearing in the files. The main surnames researched by Bobbie O'Brien are underlined in the left hand column and in the right hand column are the main surname groupings that information on that family can be found in:
