

Rutledge Family Research Notes

The following are research notes compiled on the descendants of William Rutledge (c1765-1846) of Surry County, NC, who settled in Daviess, Hancock and Ohio Counties, Ky. One of his daughters, Lucy Rutledge Howell (1810-1892); and several grandchildren including – Enos Jefferson Rutledge (1829-1857), Thomas D. Rutledge (1832-1917), Isaac Wilson Rutledge (c1835-1896), Joseph Arch Rutledge (c1841-1874/1880) & James Walker Rutledge (1871-1960), who were sons of William W. Rutledge; and Amelia Hudspeth Allgood (1812017877) & Lucy E. Hudspeth Thomas (1830-1872), who were daughters of Mary Rutledge Hudspeth.

notes: Henry Thomas Rutledge's birth (6 Oct. 1856) is recorded in the 1852-1861 Daviess County, KY Vital Statistics. In the 1870 & 1880 Daviess County censuses Thomas is listed in the home of James W. & Martha Price (his mother & stepfather), in the 1880 Daviess County census Thomas is living in the village of Yelvington, in the home of Jim & Ella Jackson. James W. & Martha Price were not found in the 1880 or 1900 Daviess County censuses, Daviess County cemetery listings, or in the newspaper obituary listings at the Owensboro Public Library.

Both parties are the only heirs of I. W. Rutledge, deceased. Page 80, on same date, William T. Rutledge sold to Margaret E. Roberts another 53 acres on Blackford.

Book 69-p102 27 March 1899, Ed Hector sold to William T. Rutledge 25 acres on Moores Road. Bounded by Lizzie Roberts. Part of what is known as the I. W. Rutledge land.

- p20 11 June 1880, attended the funeral of Wils Rutledge's child and held a short religious service.

aunt, Margaret Roberts Nestler, was living in Florida and she would contact her to see if she wanted to talk to me.

Mrs Bruce (Mae A. Roberts) Milne. 2515 Spencer Dr., Owensboro, KY 42301, phone 502-684-5440 on 27 August 1885 by Jerry Long

Daughter of Taylor Roberts & Mary Eubanks and granddaughter of Fred Roberts & Mae Vernon Taylor. Mrs. Milne said her grandparents had 4 children: 1. Taylor, born 5 Aug. 1916 Ohio Co., KY, died 29 Sep. 1967 Owensboro, buried near his father at Rose Hill Cemetery in Owensboro. He married 3 times, 1st Mary Eubanks, 12 Oct. 1934 in Owensboro, they had one child, Mae Anna, wife of Bruce W. Milne (partner with his brothers, Marshall & Robert, dec' d, in Milne' s Greenhouse). Taylor Roberts married 2nd Louise Turner, they had two children, Taylor, Jr. & Kenneth. Taylor, Sr. about 1960 married 3rd Bessie May, no children. 2. Sarah Dorothy, born 3 April 1919 Daviess Co., KY, married 3 times, 1st husband was a Gaylor, she died at Calvert City, KY 1962-1967. 3. Martha, born 1 Feb. 1923 Daviess Co., KY, married Howard Curd, she died 14 Oct. 1985 Owensboro, buried in Rose Hill Cemetery, they had two children, Greg & Vicki (wife of Joe Holman). And 4. Margaret, twin, born 1 Feb 1923, married twice, Ed Skoudis & Vern Nestler, living New Port Richey, FL. Mrs. Milne did not have a record of her grandfather, Fred Roberts', date of birth (his monument at the cemetery only has the year of his birth). Roberts, also has a monument at the same cemetery, he married Mary Elizabeth Rutledge (she said her first name was not Margaret, as I had found in the deed records), they were her grandparents. She has no records of her grandmother's birth or death, she believes she is buried at the Bethlehem Church by her husband in an unmarked grave. She does not know her parents names or if she had any siblings and never knew of any Rutledge relations. Charlie & 'Lizzie' Roberts had three children, Robert, Fred & Harry, they had no middle names. 1. Robert, married Maude Campbell and moved to Webb City, Missouri (near Joplin). He was buried at Webb City. They had three children: Kathryn, married a McKinder, lived & died at Joplin, MO; Mary married a Yeager, the last she heard she was living at Webb City; & Kenneth, lived & died at Joplin, MO. 2. Fred Roberts, born 5 Jan. 1893, married Mae V. Taylor, they divorced but later remarried, they had four children (granddaughter Mrs. Bruce Milne. Fred in his last years lived with, Florence, who was named as a wife in his obituary, but she said they were never married. And 3. Harry Roberts, born 4 Aug. 1895 Daviess Co., KY, married Burris Ray, 17 Jan. 1916 at Rockport, IN, She was born 20 Sep. 1898 & died 23 Nov. 1951, buried at the Bethlehem Methodist Church, Daviess Co., KY. He then married Mrs. Cora Mae Hoover, they had no children. Five children were born to Harry & Burris; all born in Daviess Co., KY: 1. Louise, born 5 June 1916, married Claudie Jarvis & John Sanchez, she died 1983 in Arkansas. 2. Charlie William,

Gideon A. Allgood, was born in Yadkin County, N.C., Jan. 27, 1848. His father, James
Allgood, was born in North Carolina, in 1811, and came to Daviess County in 1855, where he
died March 10, 1860. His mother, Amelia (Hudspeath) Allgood, was born in North Carolina in
1812, and died in 1877, leaving four children – Nathan B., John L., Fiza A., and Gideon. Mr.
Allgood was reared on a farm, and went to school at intervals until twenty-four years of age. He
is a single man. In 1872 he was elected Constable to fill out the term of Robert Ellis, resigned.
He served as Deputy Sheriff a year and a half, and as Deputy Assessor two years. In 1878 he was

elected Assessor, and re-elected in 1882. He is a member of the Baptist church, and of Yelvington Lodge No. 693, A.F. & A.M.

Interview of: Edwin C. Allgood, 1148 Ray Road, Daviess County, KY, phone 502-264-1036, on 15 August 1995 by Jerry Long:

Mr. Allgood's father, Nathan Boon Allgood, Jr., was born on 29 July 1888 in Daviess County. He is buried a short distance from Mr. Allgood's home in the Iron Ore Hill Cemetery, his grave is unmarked, he died in 1948. He married twice, his first wife, Hattie Neutie Spillman, died and he married her sister, Nellie Golden Spillman. By his first marriage their only child, William, died in infancy, and four children were born to the second marriage, they were: 1). Mable Helen, died age 20. 2). Dorothy May, born 2 April 1917, married Lloyd Russell Hayden at Rockport, IN in 1936. 3). Edwin C. (only an initial), born 26 Feb. 1920, married first Clara Elizabeth Roehm on 7 Dec. 1946 in Owensboro, she was born 5 March 1921 in Daviess County, KY to James Roehm & Peachie Bailey, & died 1 Sep. 1974 in Daviess County; he married second Louise Parker 11 July 1975 in Springfield, TN. By his first marriage two children were born, Janice, born 30 Oct. 1947 & Edwin, Jr., born 3 Oct. 1952, both live in Daviess County. And 4) Frances Marion, born 11 Sep. 1923, married Cleatus Howard.

He does not have a record of his mother's birth date, he was 13 when she died. She (Nellie G. Spillman Allgood) was born in Daviess County on the farm that Mr. Allgood owns. The farm has been in his family over 100 years. It had been acquired by his great-grandfather, William Newtie Spillman (buried at the Bethlehem Methodist Church). It then went to his grandfather, Jonathan Dean Spillman (married Mattie B. Hays), he died in 1949 and in 1950 Mr. Allgood purchased it from the other heirs. His grandfather, Nathan Boon Allgood, Sr., died in 1922, and was buried at the Yelvington Cemetery. He owned three farms. He has no pictures of him or any written records on the family. His grandmother was a Shryock. He knows of six children that his grandparents had: 1). Ben, married Hattie Bray, he died in 1925. They had no children, but raised Ollie Ellis, whose father, Frank Ellis of Rockport, IN brought her to their home and left her; she was of no relation to them. Ollie married William Parker and died in Florida in 1985 and was brought back and buried at the Yelvington Cemetery. Mattie Bray. married 2nd a May and 3rd a Leisure, she died about 1953 and was buried Yelvington. 2). Gid, married Fannie, she was from France, she died in Des Moines, IA and was buried there. They had no children. 3). Nathan B., Jr. 4). Winnie, married a Bean, lived and died in Ohio County, KY, they had no children. 5). Della, never married. And 6). Willie, married William Board. She died at Rockfield, near Bowling Green, KY and was buried in the latter place. They had two daughters, but neither had any children. They were: Permelia, never married, and Helen, married Nathaniel Tutt. The William C. Allgood listed as a nephew in his aunt Dell Allgood.'s obit was William Christian and was a son of one of Mr. Allgood's fathers sisters, but he did not know which one, William C. lived in Tennessee. Nathan B. Allgood, Sr. had brothers William, Gideon & John and a sister, Fizzy (she never married). William had no children but raised several adopted children, one was Kate Hector, whose husband, John Q. Stone, cheated another ward, Mrs. Mary Bell and her two children out of their inheritance. John Allgood had a son, George, who lived in Southern Indiana. Gideon Allgood served as Daviess County Assessor, he was a midget, his upper body was normal size but his legs were very short. He had a daughter, Kate, who was also a midget, she never married, about 1940 she was living around Whitesville, KY. He does not know the names of his Allgood great-grandparents, but she was a Hudspeth. He has an old picture of a Hudspeth, not sure of the name.

On 25 August 1995 called Mr. Allgood a second time to ask him some additional questions. He said after talking to me he had found a record of his grandparents, Nathan B. Allgood & Helen Shryock's family. It was on a large piece of paper and at the top was "God Bless Our Family", on it was recorded the following data:

Mr. Allgood said his father, Nathan B.'s middle name was spelled "Boone". His aunt Dell Allgood was buried at Rose Hill Cemetery in Owensboro and his aunt Winnie Allgood Bean may have been buried at the Adaburg Cemetery in Ohio County and not at the Cates Cemetery as he had told me before. Told Mr. Allgood I had found that the gravestone of William H. Allgood (26 Dec. 1880 - 2 Jan. 1881), a son of his great-uncle John, had been found in 1994 along the banks of Carpenters Lake by the family of Charles E. Burton of near Yelvington [see Aug 1995 issue of Kentucky Family Records, Vol.19, p39, West-Central Kentucky Family Research Association, Owensboro, KY]. In an earlier listing of the Yelvington Cemetery the same monument had been listed and on my recent visit to the cemetery I could not find it. Just before calling Mr. Allgood I had phoned Mrs. Burton and she said she still had the monument and any family member was welcomed to it. Mr. Allgood said he would like to see that it was returned to its rightful place and would do so.

Mrs. Thomas lives about mile west of Yelvington, in Daviess County, KY. Her late husband, Benjamin Hawes Thomas, was born 10 Dec. 1907 near Yelvington. He married Corinna Marie Robertson, 25 Feb. 1937, at Livermore, KY. They had 3 children: Mary Marie, born 10 Dec. 1937 Daviess Co., KY, married William Clifford Fuller, living at Clarksville, TN; Bonnie Hawes, born 12 March 1941 Daviess Co., KY, married Parvin Bishop, living at Dallas, TX; & Patsy Hope, born 21 Oct. 1946 Daviess Co., KY, married Joseph John Galati, living at Danville, CA.

Ben H. Thomas was the son of Joseph Alexander Thomas & Mary Ann Hawes, Mrs. Thomas and other heirs still own their old home, it is now rented out. It is on Highway 405, about mile west of Yelvington, first house on south side of road just past Pleasure Point Road (going east from Maceo to Yelvington). The home was given to them shortly after their marriage by Mary Ann's parents, Sam & Patsy Hawes. Joe A. & Mary Ann had 6 children: 1). Lucy Lander, died when about 18 of scarlet fever, buried by parents at Elmwood Cemetery in Owensboro. 2). Margaret Lillian, married Horace Emmick, they had no children. 3). Marianne, never married. 4). Patty Moorman, married Lawrence Lashbrook, they had no children. 5). Benjamin Hawes. And 6). Samuel Joseph, married Ona Hope, 16 Nov. 1935, at Jasper, IN, they had no children, she is residing at a convalescent home in Owensboro.

Ben H. Thomas' grandparents are buried at the Yelvington Cemetery. Mrs. Thomas does not remember their names, but said he was a merchant, and she was originally a Hudspeth. She has an old picture of them. If a copy is needed she said I could borrow it to have copies made. In their family there were 5 boys and 1 girl, the boys before marrying were musicians and performed on riverboats. Their children were: 1). Joseph Alexander. 2). Lillie, married a Dempsey, he died young, leaving her with two girls to raise, she later lived Cincinnati, OH and New York, NY, not sure when and where she died. A cousin, Dell Allgood, of Yelvington, went with them and helped to care for the girls while Mrs. Dempsey worked. Her daughters were Mary Lucy, who married a Dr. Roberts, died and buried at Birmingham, AL, and Frederica, always went by Fred, married a Greenwood, lived at Detroit, MI, but died and was buried at Birmingham, AL. 3). James William, lived and died at Dundee in Ohio County, KY. Had 1 daughter, Martha, who married Jim Harrison, lived at Detroit, MI, later moved back to Dundee and then to Owensboro, where she died. She had one son, William Harrison, who is living at Brownsville, Texas. 4). Andrew Jackson, lived at Yelvington, never, married, is buried at Elmwood Cemetery in Owensboro, his grave is unmarked. 5) June, lived & died at Indianapolis,

IN, had a son, Jack Thomas, who lives in Beech Grove, a suburb of Indianapolis, his phone # is 317-786-2321. Mrs. Thomas said she could remember hearing that her husband was related to the Rutledge family, one of whom was a signer of the Declaration of Independence. She said she would be very interested in obtaining for her children some of the early history of their family.
