

Schroader Cemetery

Ohio County, KY

Located about six miles northeast of Hartford on the farm of the late Homer K. Young (1912-1993). His sons reside there now. On the west side of the Halls Creek Road a little over a mile south of Highway 1164 turn into the Young Lane. At end of lane in front of house walk to the right, cross small creek, and follow path up hill. At the top of hill the cemetery is a short distance on the left.

The immediate vicinity of the farm is known as Red Hill and this section of the county is also referred to as Hell's Neck. Adam Schroader (1815-1885) moved to this farm in 1847 from Warren County, KY. His father, Frederick Schroader (c1790-1868), had moved to Ohio County about five years earlier. The tax lists show Adam paying taxes on this property from 1847 but he was not deeded the farm (215 acres on Wolf Fork of Halls Creek) until 8 October 1855 (Ohio County Deed Book O - p573). The 28 January 1885 issue of the Hartford Herald newspaper ran the following article:

Died: Schroader – At the residence of the deceased, near Mt. Vernon church, Thursday, January the 22d, 1885, after a long and painful illness caused by paralysis, Mr. Adam Schroader, aged 69 years 11 months and 14 days. Deceased was born in Warren county and moved to Ohio county many years ago, where he raised a large family of children. He lived a very exemplary life and in his palmier days was noted for his industry. His remains were interred on Saturday in the grave-yard on the farm on which he lived.

Homer K. Young (1912-1993), a great-grandson of Adam Schroader, acquired about 60 acres of the farm. He got part of the tract from his parents, William D. & Martisha (Wright) Young in 1937. Adam Schroader had transferred 40 acres at the lower end of his farm to his son-in-law, William T. Wright, in 1873 (Deed Book 71 – p282). W. T. Wright in 1928 deeded it to his son, Adam D. Wright, who sold it to his sister, Martisha Young & her husband in 1932 (Deed Book 90 - p402, 80 – p273 & 72 – p521). Homer K. Young acquired other interest in the Adam Schroader farm from Jesse & Bettie Schroader in 1945 (Deed Books 98 – p44 & 99 – p5). In 1878 Adam Schroader and his wife, Cinderilla, sold the remaining part of their farm to their sons, William & Hiram (Ohio County Deed Book Y – p437). The Schroader School formerly stood near the mouth of the (Young) lane that leads back to the cemetery. Adam Schroader's sons, Hiram & William, donated one acre off of the southeast corner of their father's farm for the school in 1876 (Deed Book 10 – p63). The deed stated that the school building was to be used as a house of worship when school was not in session. The school closed with the consolidation of schools in the county about 1934.

The cemetery was copied by Jerry Long, Owensboro, KY on 8 September 1980 and rechecked on 13 November 1996:
