### **Notes on the Heavrin family by Jerry Long:**

James M. Heavrin (spelled as Heverin, age 71, born Delaware; and wife, Melinda (60, born Pennsylvania) are listed in the 1850 census of Anderson County, KY. Also living in their home was a Malinda Heavrin (age 24, born Kentucky. The will of James Heveren was recorded in Anderson County, KY on 10 December 1855; in it he named one child, a daughter, Malinda Ashby. James Havirin married Milly Nation in Shelby County, KY on 2 June 1805. James M. Heavrin's children included:

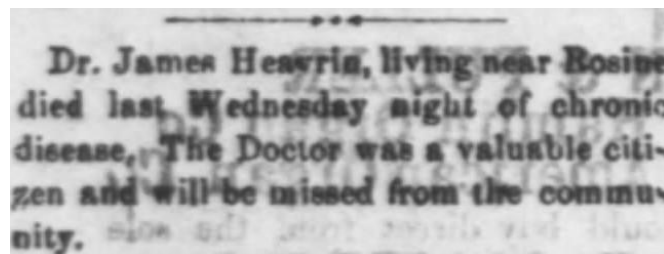
1. Benjamin, born April 1806 Shelby County, KY; married Elizabeth, c1827, and Elizabeth (Byers) Ford (1834-1922), 24 September 1863 Hartford, Ohio County, KY; died 1870

Ohio County, KY. His children included: Malinda (married Woodson Brumfield), Margaret M. (married William H. Bright), Harriett E. (married James W. Peach), Granville, Martha Ann (married William Wright), Benjamin (married Margaret E. Wright), Lillie A. (married William Douglas), Daniel B. & Ulysses Grant.

2. Martha, married William Morris, 3 September 1832 Anderson County, KY.
3. George, his son, Francis M. Heavrin , born c1837, married Artelia A. Felix, 10 June 1858 Ohio County, KY and died 18 November 1895 Daviess County, KY and was buried in the Black Cemetery, Ohio County, KY.
4. James M., born 1814 Shelby County, KY.
5. William, moved to Wisconsin.
6. John, born c1820 KY; married Jane Hockersmith, 27 January 1841 Anderson County, KY.
7. Malinda B., born 28 October 1827 KY; married Henry Riley Ashby, 1850-1855; she died 25 August 1903 Jingo, Ohio County, KY; buried Milton Taylor Cemetery, Ohio County, KY.

Dr. James M. Heavrin, Jr., son of James M. & Melinda, was born 1814 in Shelby County, in Anderson County, KY he married Barbara Ann Sterling on 24 January 1837. She was born 1817 Versailles, Woodford County, KY. James, Jr. was listed in the 1850 census of Nelson County, KY; his name was appeared under the spelling of "Evern", in his home were: Anna, 38, Mary A., 12, Sarah, 8, Eliza J., 6, and James P., 1. He moved to Ohio County, KY during 1851-1852; he first appears there in the 1852 tax list. He is listed in the 1860 & 1870 censuses of Ohio County, KY. His occupation was cited as farmer in the 1850, 1860 & 1870 censuses. He died 5 September 1878 Ohio County, KY. His wife, Barbara died 5 May 1909. They were buried in the Heavrin Cemetery.

**Heard Campbell Preach.**  
Dr. J. H. Heavrin was at Horse Branch Thursday to attend the burial of his mother, Mrs. Barbara Ann Heavrin, who died the day before at the age of ninety-one. Mrs. Heavrin was afflicted with bronchitis, and died as a result of this and old age. She was born at Versailles, Ky., and was a member of the Christian church, and in her earlier days had heard Alexander Campbell, the founder of the church.—[Hawesville Clarion.]

Children of James M. Heavrin & Barbara Ann Sterling were:

1. Mary Ann, born 28 November 1841 Anderson County, KY; married Wesley P. Miller (13 December 1844 – 17 June 1919), 25 December 1864 Ohio County, KY; she died 15 July 1901; she and her husband were buried Old Salem Cemetery, Ohio County, KY. Their children: James W., Joseph Elmer, Ulysses S. Grant, John L., Adolphus W., Robert Mitchell and Ida Beulah and Barbara E.
2. Sarah Ann, born 2 October 1844 Anderson County, KY; she was a teacher and died single on 18 November 1928 Ohio County, KY; buried Heavrin – Brown Cemetery, Ohio County, KY.
3. Eliza Jane, born 21 July 1847 Anderson County, KY; married George N. Coats, 3 May 1877 Ohio County, KY and Newton Allen Sharp, 23 November 1910 Hartford, Ohio County, KY; she died 10 August 1926 Ohio County, KY; she was buried Heavrin – Brown Cemetery, Ohio County, KY. She had one child, Roy Coats (1880-1918); he may have been buried with his mother.

4. James Porter Heavrin, born 24 November 1849 Anderson County, KY; married Sarah E. Reynolds, 14 March 1876 Daviess County, KY; he was a doctor; he died 29 June 1908 Owensboro, Daviess County, KY; buried Elmwood Cemetery, Owensboro, Daviess County, KY. He was survived by one daughter, Mrs. Goodloe M. (Grace) Morrison. A biography of him was published in the book, *History of Daviess County, Kentucky* (Chicago, Inter-State Publishing Co., 1883, pp234-235: “J. P. Heavrin, M.D., born in Anderson County, Ky., Nov. 24, 1849, is a son of Dr. James M. Heavrin, a native of the same county. He was educated at Rochester, Ky., Cromwell, Ky., and Morehead Seminary, Butler County, KY. He read medicine with Dr. N. J. Rains, of Rosine, Ky., eighteen months. He took the first course of the Kentucky School of Medicine, at Louisville in 1878-'9, and then located in Curdsville, where he has since been practicing, with the exception of one term spent. in school in 1882, when he graduated. He was married in March, 1875, to Sarah E. Reynolds. They have had two children, only one living—Grace. Dr. Heavrin is a member of the McDowell Medical Association of Northern Kentucky, the Alumni Association, and the Masonic fraternity.
  
5. Malinda Zella, born 9 June 1854 Ohio County, KY; married Clarence Edwin Raley, 22 February 1881 Ohio County, KY; she died 23 January 1927 Ohio County, KY; she and her husband were buried Heavrin – Brown Cemetery, Ohio County, KY. They had two children, Jessie M. (married Benjamin Johnson) and Bessie L. (married William Walter Hughes).
  
6. Elizabeth Maretta, born 1856Wisconsin; died single 17 June 1878 Ohio County, KY; and was buried Heavrin – Brown Cemetery, Ohio County, KY.
  
7. Georgia Ann, born 17 August 1858 Victory, Wisconsin; she was a teacher and died single 23 October 1940 Louisville, Jefferson County, KY; she was buried Heavrin – Brown Cemetery, Ohio County, KY.
  
8. John H., born July 1862 Ohio County, KY; married Jennetta H. Thixton, 1 September 1887 Owensboro, Daviess County, KY; he was a doctor, receiving a degree from a medical school in Louisville, KY, he practiced in Owensboro & Hawesville, KY; he died 30 September 1910 Hawesville, Hancock County, KY; buried Elmwood Cemetery, Owensboro, Daviess County, KY; he had no children.
