Notes on Lake family by Jerry Long:

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Abraham Lake was a native of Pennsylvania and was born about 1780, his wife, Eleanor was born about 1793, they were both living in 1850. He is listed in the 1830 census of Washington County, KY, 1840 and 1850 censuses of Marion County, KY. Four of the children of Abraham & Eleanor Lake removed to Ohio County, Ky. James and David Lake left Marion County and went to Ohio County about 1854. Between 1867 and 1870 the families of Abraham Lake, Jr. and Rebecca Lake Sapp moved to Ohio County.

The children of Abraham and Eleanor Lake included -

- Abraham, born 16 May 1816 KY; married Lucinda Smith, c1840; she was the daughter of Richard Smith and Elenor Cooper. "Abe" Lake died on 10 October 1890. His wife, Lucinda, was born 14 September 1821 and died 11 September 1906. They were both buried in the St. Mary of the Woods cemetery, a Catholic church at Whitesville in Daviess County, Ky. Their children were - Sarah, John B., George W., Matilda Ann, Mary Jane, Lucinda, Alice, Abraham and Apalona.
- 2. Isaac, born about 1824 KY; married Mary, c1846; lived Marion County, KY in 1850.
- James Sampson, born 24 February 1826 KY; married Mary Elizabeth Moseley (11 December 1831 - 11 November 1912), 11 June 1853 Daviess County, KY; died 17 September 1913 Ohio County, KY; buried Bell's Run Baptist Church Cemetery, Ohio County, KY.
- 4. Rebecca Ellen, born about 1827 Washington County, KY; married Bennett Bradford Sapp, 17 July 1845 Marion County, KY, Hilery Rhodes, 19 April 1866 Marion County, KY and George W. Hamilton, 13 September 1870 Ohio County, KY; Rebecca died 23 June 1916 Ohio County, KY; buried Adaburg Cemetery, Ohio County, KY. - 5. David, born 20 January 1833 KY; married Martha Jane Sutton of Ohio County, KY on 12 August 1854 Daviess County, KY. She was the daughter of William Sutton and Catharine Ann Ralph. In 1860 and 1870 David Lake was listed in the censuses of Ohio County, KY and in 1880 he was listed in the census of Daviess County, KY. David died 27 March 1923 Ohio County, Ky. His death certificate reported he was buried in the Prentis Cemetery, Ohio County, KY. Their children were - America E., Catharine E., James William, Allenia J., Mary B., Anna D., Maude A., Minnie M., David C., Sampson and twins Rebecca M. and Malinda V.

James William Lake, son of David C. Lake & Martha Jane Sutton, was born 22 July 1860; married Delilia Alverda Hoover (1 October 1856 – 13 March 1938), 29 March 1880 Ohio County, KY. James W. died 9 October 1939 Ohio County, KY; he and his wife were buried in the Lake Cemetery, Ohio County, KY.
