## **A comparative study of census and tax records of Ohio County**

This book seeks to identify and trace Ohio County's early settlers by the use of the county's census and tax records. The author has studied and copied the 1779 and 1800 tax lists, censuses of 1810, 1820, 1830, and 1840, and made additions to the censuses from the tax lists of 1811, 1820, 1830, and 1839. All records are copied in their original form. One comprehensive index is a comparative study of each surname from year to year. The families that lived in Ohio County from one generation to another in its early days are identified and listed. By the random sampling of records from 1799 to 1840 it is hoped that this book will give a good enumeration of the early settlers of Ohio County and will facilitate research on their families.

## **INTRODUCTION**

Ohio County, Kentucky is situated in the west central portion of the state; lying on the waters of Green River, which forms its southern and a part of its southwestern boundary. Bordered by the counties of Daviess, Hancock, Breckinridge, Grayson, Butler, Muhlenberg, and Mclean,

Ohio County was formed in 1798, out of part of Hardin County, the 35th county in order of formation. Named after the Ohio River, which was its northern boundary until 1815 when its daughter county of Daviess was formed from its northern territory.

The first explorers entered the region that is Ohio County today as early as 1775-1776, and the first permanent settlements were made circa 1780. To identify and trace the earliest settlers of Ohio County one would have to search the records of its parent counties.

Successively before its formation the region of the county of Ohio was under the jurisdiction of: Fincastle County, Virginia (1772-1776); Kentucky County, Virginia (1776-1780); Jefferson County, Virginia (1780-1784); Nelson County, Virginia (1785-1792); Nelson County, Kentucky (June 1792-February 1793); and Hardin County, Kentucky (1793-1799).

At the time of the first settlements in Kentucky in 1774, the territory of present Ohio County and the state of Kentucky was part of Fincastle County, Virginia. In the first year of the Republic of the United States, 1776, by an act of the Virginia Legislature, the county of Fincastle was abolished and divided into three new counties - Kentucky, Washington, and Montgomery Counties, Virginia. Kentucky County, Virginia was comprised of the land encompassing the present state of Kentucky. On November 1st, 1780 Kentucky County was abolished and its territory divided into Jefferson, Lincoln, and Fayette Counties, Virginia. January 1st, 1785 Nelson County was formed from the southern and western extremities of Jefferson County, Virginia.

On June 1, 1792 Kentucky was admitted as the 15th state in the Union, Nelson County, Virginia thus became Nelson County, Kentucky, and included among its inhabitants were the early settlers of Ohio County.

In the first year of statehood on December 15th the Kentucky Legislature ordered that on February 20, 1793 Hardin County was to be established from Nelson. The county of Hardin, the 16th in Kentucky, was about 140 miles long with an average width of 50 miles. The boundaries were made chiefly by following the courses of the Rivers: the Rolling Fork and Salt River to the Ohio, the Ohio to the mouth of Green River, south and east along Green River with a line over the hills to Rolling Fork. Its territory encompassed the present counties of: Ohio (1799), Breckinridge (1800), Grayson (1810), Daviess (1815), Meade (1824), Hancock (1829), Larue (1843), and parts of Butler (1810), Hart (1819), Edmonson (1825), and McLean (1854). In the early court records of Hardin County can be found many of the names of the early citizens of Ohio County.

The Kentucky Legislature on December 17, 1798 passed an act for erecting a new county out of the county of Hardin. The official decree read as follows:

Be it enacted by the General Assembly that from and after the first day of July next, all that part of the county of Hardin that is included in the following bounds, viz: Beginning on the Ohio River at the mouth of Blackford's Creek, thence up the same to the head of the southeast fork that heads opposite the head of Harris's fork of Rock Lick Creek, thence across the dividing ridge to said Harris's Fork, thence down the same to Rock Lick Creek, thence down the same to Rough Creek, thence a straight line to Flat Clay Lick on Bear Creek, and down the same to Green River, and down Green River to the Ohio to the beginning, shall be one distinct county, and called and known by the name of Ohio. But the said county of Ohio shall not be entitled to a separate representation until the number of free male inhabitants therein contained above the age of twenty-one years shall entitle them to one representative, agreeable to the ratio that shall hereafter be established by law.

A court for the said county shall be held by the justices thereof on the first Tuesday in every month, except in the months the court of quarter sessions are hereafter directed to be held, after said division shall take place, in the manner as is provided by law in respect to other counties and as shall be by their commissions directed.

The justices to be named in the commission of the peace for said county of Ohio shall meet at the house of Robert Moseley, in the said county, on the first court day after said division shall take place, and having taken the oaths



prescribed by law, and the sheriff being duly qualified to act, the justices shall proceed to appoint and qualify a clerk, and fix upon a place to hold courts in the said county, at or as near the center thereof as the situation and convenience of the place will admit; and thenceforth the court shall proceed to erect necessary public buildings at such place, and until such buildings be completed, to appoint such place for holding court as they shall think proper. Provided always, that the appointment for a place for erecting the public buildings, and of a clerk, shall not be made unless a majority of the justices of the court of the said county concur therein; but such appointment shall be postponed until some court day when a majority shall be present, but the court may appoint a clerk pro tempore.

And be it further enacted, that the court of quarter sessions for the said county shall be held, annually, in the months of November, February, April, and June.

It shall be lawful for the sheriff of Hardin to collect and make distress for any public dues or officers' fees which shall remain unpaid by the inhabitants thereof at the time such division shall take place, and he shall be accountable for the same in like manner as if this act had not been made.

And the court of the said county of Hardin shall have jurisdiction in. all actions and suits in law and equity which shall be depending before them at the time of such division, and shall try and determine the same, issue process, and award execution thereon. (Note: The original resolution was passed December 17, 1798 but a year later, on December 19, 1799, a revision to the original resolution was made to correct an error. The error was in the omission of the words "Rough Creek, thence a straight line to" and in the name "Flat Clay Creek", which should have read "Flat Clay Lick", The above includes these revisions.)

The original territory of Ohio County has undergone several divisions since its formation. In 1809 a small strip of north western Ohio County was transferred to Henderson County. In 1810 Grayson County was formed out of sections of eastern Ohio County and western Hardin County. In 1815 Daviess County was formed from the northern territory of Ohio County. In 1829 a small strip on the northeast of Ohio County was added to parts of Daviess and Breckinridge Counties to form Hancock County. In 1830 a section in the Panther Creek area of northern Ohio County was added to Daviess County. In 1831 the northeastern tip of Ohio County was transferred to Breckinridge County. And in 1854 a small area on the west of Ohio County along with parts of Daviess and Muhlenberg Counties was used to create McLean County. The boundaries of Ohio County for the last 129 years have remained the same.

The county seat of Ohio County, Hartford, located on the banks of Rough Creek, was incorporated in 1808.

Who were the early citizens and settling families of Ohio County? This question is the purpose for this publication. This effort seeks to identify and trace Ohio County's early settlers by the use of the county's census and tax records, from 1799 to 1840.

In The Researcher's Guide To American Genealogy, Val D. Greenwood concerning the use of censuses states; "There is probably no other single group of records in existence which contains more information about persons and families who lived during the 1800's than do the

population schedules of the U.S. federal censuses. Though these population censuses are mostly unindexed, and only on rare occasions are families arranged alphabetically (in a few counties in some of the earlier years), their value is great. A census search can be laborious and very time-consuming as you must read name-by-name and page-by-page, but research on no American genealogical problem is complete until all pertinent census schedules have been searched."

The first official census of Ohio County was taken one year after its formation, in 1800. Every ten years thereafter a Federal Census has been conducted in the county. Through the most recent, 1980 census, there have been 19 in all; however, the 1890 census is no longer in existence having been destroyed by a fire in 1921.

The population of Ohio County as reported by the census takers for its first eight censuses, is as follows;

By Federal law information on individuals from the censuses is confidential and restricted for 72 years. Under this law the 1910 Census has only within the last year been released for public scrutiny. The 1910 and earlier censuses are available to any interested individual, and can be viewed on microfilmed copies at most public libraries.

At this writing three censuses of Ohio County have been transcribed and published in book form: the 1850 by West Central Kentucky Family Research Association (c.1974), the 1860 by Bobbie H. O'Brien (c.1981), and the 1870 by Robert D. McManaway (c.1982). Also in substitution for the lost 1890 census Sam McDowell has published the 1890 Ohio County Tax List (c.1982). These sources are a great research tool to the family historian, making it relatively simple to locate a particular individual in a census. No longer is it necessary to spend hours meticulously searching a microfilmed census name by name, often failing to find who you are searching for either because he was not there, or you failed to decipher the handwriting correctly, or you blinked your eye at the wrong time.

For this publication the writer has studied and copied the Ohio County 1799-1800 tax lists and censuses of 1810-1820-1830-1840. This makes it possible, now, to trace the early settlers of Ohio County through its first seventy years by the use of indexed census books. This effort is dedicated to the individuals, who gave many hours in compiling the publications cited above. It is my hope that other dedicated historians will also copy and publish the 1880 and 1900 censuses of Ohio County.

I caution the researcher to remember that census records, though they can contain a wealth of information, they should only be used as a rough guideline and not as a final proof, for they sometimes contain many misleading inconsistencies and errors regarding names, ages, members of household. The value of a single census listing is enhanced and often clarified when compared with prior or subsequent census listings for that individual or with other public or

family records. Generally genealogical data comes in bits and pieces and like the working of a puzzle has to be carefully examined and fitted together to arrive at the complete (or clearer) picture.

This book begins with the first tax list of Ohio County, 1799. The copy, made herein, as the original shows: all male tithables over 21 in the county, number of free white males over 21 (some few individuals over 21 were exempt from payment of the county levy and thus were not listed, even though they would be numbered in this separate category), free white males 16-21, as well as land (acreage and water course), number of slaves, and horses owned by each individual tax payer.

The 1799 tax listing, as all census and tax records transcribed in this book, was done by trying to faithfully follow order, spelling, and category totals of the original copy. All copies were rechecked with the original to see that this had been done. I am confident that order and category totals have been maintained, also I believe spellings are largely (as far as possible) as they originally appear. However, there are some instances because of fading or inconsistencies in the handwriting where an exact interpretation was not possible, and an interpretation could only be made by comparison to other records. A few instances that defied all efforts of interpretation are in the transcribed copy accompanied by a question mark.

The 1799 tax record is followed by the 1800 tax list. For the 1800, only the taxpayers are listed here, the other information of the original, as included for the 1799, was not copied. Forty-seven names were found to be in the original 1800 tax list that do not appear in a previous published listing for the 1800 (see Kentucky Family Records Volume IV, page 5, published by West Central Kentucky Family Research Association). In 1799 there were 187 taxpayers listed, in 1800 there were 200. The total white population in 1800 was 1069, indicating that on the average for each taxpayer there would be an additional five individuals in the county, including women, children, and tax exempts.

The 1800 tax list is followed by in chronological order the 1810, 1820, 1830, and 1840 censuses of Ohio County. The population schedules for these years, unlike the 1850 and later censuses, do not list the names of all members in each household. These schedules for this period show only the name of the household head. He, and all other members of that household were accounted for numerically, by totals in age groupings under the categories of sex and race, respectively. It is important to remember that these numbers generally correspond to immediate members of the householders family, but often also indicate extended family members or others not even related such as hired hands or boarders.

At the taking of every census there are families and individuals missed, due to numerous factors. Every genealogist has had experiences where he has searched and searched for someone who should have been there. He was there before and after, and in records of the same time, but is not to be found in the given census.

A few individuals, as is the case even today, actively avoided the census taker either out of backwardness, suspiciousness, or sheer stubbornness. Some people lived in isolated areas of the county and along with the poor traveling conditions, were never located and not known to exist by the enumerator. Another factor involved was the length of time allotted to the census taker to complete his enumeration. Before 1850 the census taker had up to 9 months, in 1850 he had 5 months, and in 1870 he had one month. Coupled with the fact the population in early times was so very mobile, an individual could have been missed by the fact he moved during the year. He was in neither area when the census taker was there. This factor also evidences itself in the fact that some families, especially single individuals, were enumerated twice in the same census.

I have seen many examples where an individual was listed twice in the censuses after 1850, and no doubt it was also the case in the earlier censuses as well.

In lieu of the fact that some individuals are missed, each census of Ohio County in this book was evaluated in relationship to the accompanying tax list of the county for the same year. Tax lists are in many ways more accurate and complete compilations of a county's inhabitants than the census schedules. The revenues of the county depended upon the thoroughness of the tax commissioner, thus the need was intense for ferreting out all eligible taxpayers.

Each transcribed census is followed by a list of additional taxpayers, who are males over 21 appearing in the tax list in addition to the heads of households listed in the census. In other words, the names of household heads in the census were deleted from the tax list, and all remaining names were copied.

These additional taxpayers over 21 can fall into several categories, a small percentage are individuals who have either died or moved during the course of the census year and taxes are still assessed in their name, or a few may be non-residents paying property taxes on land owned in Ohio County, but the greater number are either individuals who have been enumerated in the census but not as household heads or they are individuals who may have been missed by the census taker. These lists are intended as a supplement to the census, a more complete enumeration of residents of the county. These names are largely active residents of the county, but who are not named in the census!

Where there are individuals of the same name in the tax list, who are not named in the census, they are listed followed by a number in parenthesis indicating the total of that name in the tax list. For example, if there are three John Smiths in the tax list but only one John Smith in the census, the tax listing would be: "John Smith (3), John Smith", indicating that there are three John Smiths in the tax list with two not named in the census.

For the 1810 Census the 1811 tax list was used as a comparison, since the 1810 tax list is missing, also the 1839 tax list was used in place of the missing 1840 tax list. The 1820 and 1830 tax lists were used in conjunction with the censuses of the same year.

For the 1810-1820-1830-1840 censuses of Kentucky a computer index has been compiled and published by Accelerated Indexing Systems, Inc., and are available in larger genealogical library collections. In preparation of this book I first studied the peculiarities and similarities of the census takers handwriting, and then transcribed the original as closely as I could. Afterwards I went to these published indexes and copied all listings for Ohio County, and made comparisons between the two interpretations as a check on my original interpretation. In a few instances after reevaluation I changed my original in agreement with this second view. In other instances after some debate I concluded I was correct and the index had missed. Surprisingly for the 1810 and 1820 there were only a few minor differences in the two interpretations, in the 1810 only 9 and 11 in the 1820. In the 1830 there were appreciably more differences, 64 in all, largely due to difference in interpretation in one letter. For the 1810, 1820, and 1830 censuses the differences between my interpretation (which I decided to stand by) and the census index interpretation are listed following each census, so that the reader if he so desires can go to the original census page and determine how he sees it.

The writing of the 1840 census was the most tedious and difficult to evaluate. As a consequence the differences between the two interpretations were considerably more. Originally some 299 differences were found. After comparison of these differences with the original I subsequently changed 40 of my first interpretations. Of the other differences some were due to the omission in the census index of "Jr." and "Sr." and middle initials where they appeared in the

original, a large number was due to differences in interpretation of a and o's and e and i's. But a great number of the computer index listings I found to be markedly different misrepresentations of the original, and for that reason I did not see the value of listing these differences as done in the other censuses.

Category totals were crossed checked for each census to make sure no errors were made in copying. Cross checking was done by addition of each age category column to see if it matched the census takers subtotals for that page of the original, and number of tallies for each household were added to see if it matched the totals given in the original. By this method 12 mistakes, due to the misplacement of a tally in the wrong column, in the original copying of the four censuses were detected and corrected. Also by this method one household in the 1840 census was found to have been omitted, this household that of William Greyer was added to the end of that census, accompanied by a notation of its proper order. This is the only household found subsequently to be out of the order of the original.

All category totals for the 1810, 1830, and 1840 censuses perfectly match with the census takers final tabulations. However, in the 1820 census despite repeated rechecks I could not arrive at this same agreement. Instead I found that in seven different columns the page subtotals for that column did not match what the census taker had entered for that column. An addition of 16 individuals in the final tabulation was found in the 1820 census for which the census taker had made no appropriate individual tally in any household.

A separate index does not accompany each tax list or census in this book. One comprehensive index was compiled. The following records - the 1799 tax list, the 1800 tax list, 1810 census, 1811 tax list additions, 1820 census, 1820 tax list additions, 1830 census, 1830 tax list additions, 1839 tax list additions, and the 1840 census - have been included in the index. A single index even though considerably more complicated in its use than separate indexes, was thought to have greater value as a research tool in providing a cross comparison of each surname from year to year, and record to record. By the random sampling of records from 1799 to 1840 it is my hope that this book will give a good enumeration of the early settlers of Ohio County and will facilitate research on their families.

The index used for this book is both "comprehensive" and "evaluative". Comprehensive in that all records transcribed in the book appear in this one index. Generally in books of multiple censuses each census is indexed separately. But my purpose in writing this book was to identify and trace the early settlers of Ohio County, and one comprehensive index of records surveyed best served this purpose.

The index is used as a census of Ohio County's citizens from 1799 to 1840. Obviously it is not all inclusive. Many early citizens just passed through and did not tarry long enough to appear in any of the records sampled here or leave many footprints o the soil of Ohio County. However, the index is a chronicle of the permanent settlers of the county. The families that lived here from one generation to another in this early period of Ohio County are identified and listed alphabetically by this index.

The index includes the following records: 1799 tax list, 1800 tax list, 1810 census, 1811 tax list additions (to the 1810 census), 1820 census, 1820 tax list additions: 1830 census, 1830 tax list additions, 1839 tax list additions, and the 1840 census.

The index is also "evaluative". Regularly indexes are a thorough and precise listing of all names as they appear in the body of a book. Listing is independent of the correctness of spelling. Each listing is not evaluated to determine "the way it should be" or the general or most accepted spelling, but is instead listed "as is". If there is indeed an error in the original that error will appear also in the index, leaving it the responsibility of the reader to detect and make his own correction. By and large this rule of indexing is sufficient since the writer has tried to be correct as he composed the original. However, in the present work the, original authors, the tax commissioners and census takers, were not so precise and accurate.

The spelling of names by the writers herein cannot be depended upon. A great deal of it was by sound and names were inaccurately spelled. From record to record there are many variations of a given name, sometimes far and remote from the way the actual family spelled it. In some few instances different members of the same family may also have spelled their name in different ways.

As a result of the complexity of spelling a straight index was not used for this book. Instead in order to "make some sense of", organize, and correct the tremendous variation and mistakes in spelling of names in these records an evaluation and comparative study was done to determine the correct or most accepted (or common) spelling. All names appearing in the above cited records are included in the index. However, they are not in all cases indexed according to the spelling of the original, source, but instead by a singular corrected version of the spelling for that individual name.

In the various records of this book the name of one of my grandfathers, Absalom Albin, appears in three versions: Albin, Albion, and Abin. For many years I could not find him in the 1840 census. Not until the preparation of this book did I discover that the indistinct listing of "Absolom Abin" in the 1840 was him. The vagueness of the census listing is illustrated by the fact that the interpreter for the 1840 computerized census index listed this name as "Alvin". In

the following index the two incorrect variations of his name are not indexed as main listings but are cited and appear under the corrected version of the name, Albin.

The listing for the Albin family appears in the index as follows:

On the first line of each family listing in the index appears the correct (or the most common) version of that family name, underlined, followed by other variations found in the records of Ohio County researched for this study. Various information is organized into four columns under each family:

Column 1: Alphabetically under the family name are listed individual members that appear in the records transcribed here.

Column 2: In the middle of the listing is the record source in which that individual appears. The code used gives the year of that record followed by either the letter "c" or "t", indicating whether that record is a census or tax list, respectively.

Column 3: Following the code for a particular record appears any variations in spelling of that source from the accepted listing on the left. This column is also used to give any specific information given in the original such as "Jr." & "Sr.", "Mrs.", or free Black (not always stated but evident by the given census listing). In the case of tax lists where there are individuals (not appearing in the census for that year) of the same name the total number in the tax list appears in this column in parenthesis.

Column 4: In the right hand column appears the page of this book where that individual can be found. [\[Note: page numbers of original book are not included in the following listing of index.\]](#)

To determine an accepted spelling of names for this index a study of Ohio County records was done. By comparison of these records in most cases the actual spelling became readily apparent. However, for more uncommon names it was not always possible to determine what was correct and in these cases the most common variation was chosen as the listing for the index.

The record sources of Ohio County used for this study were as follows:

By far the majority of the names in the records transcribed for this book, even though being varied, can by someone with some familiarity of that family be easily identified and recognized as a particular individual. However, there are many names that are so obscure and deviant that one would not realize who this was. Only by extended knowledge of a particular family and careful comparison of the census with other records of the same time period can one identify who this individual is supposed to be.

The following case is cited as an illustration of the complexity and confusion that sometimes is evidenced in the spelling of these records. In the 1810 census members of the Atherton family are listed by the name "Arington". A casual reader would not readily realize who these Aringtons were. However, after a comparative study one would realize that nowhere else in the counties records does the name Arington appear, and that Athertons resided in the county at the time with the same first names as these Aringtons. Since the Athertons appear nowhere else in the census it becomes evident that these Aringtons are indeed Athertons. The census taker in the same census, on a different day, listed another member of the Atherton family in another area of the county as "Etherton". Add to this confusion the fact that it appears that Henry Addington, an immediate neighbor of the Atherton family, is for some reason also listed by the name "Arington" by the 1810 census taker. This is indicated by the following facts: He is in the area of the County where he should appear, he is in that years tax list and nowhere else in the census, no record of a Henry Arington or Henry Atherton is found, and the census listing corresponds with later census records for Henry Addington. Thus it is my conclusion that this Henry Arington is not Henry Atherton but is instead Henry Addington.

Though the above case is one of the more extreme, complex, and devious examples of variation found, it shows the maze that can be presented by spellings, and makes it clear that these records are not always what they appear to be. An imperative warning to the reader is insinuated by the above and other such examples. The family historian in his use of public

records, as those of this book, should be alerted and pre-warned to their inherent pitfalls by the salient labels of either; "Handle with care!" or "Warning! Proceed with Caution".

The following are some explanations and points of caution that the reader should keep in mind in his use and interpretation of these records and the following index:

1. The list of variations for each family name is not an exhaustive listing of all possible variations but is only those observed in the preparation of this book.
2. Be alerted to the fact that all variations of a given name may not have been connected to the proper or correct version of that family name. Most variations in names involve only two or three letters, generally in the vowels or ending of the name. Though infrequent other variations of a more extreme, dissimilar, and disguised nature were found to occur in each of the records. Some examples are: In the 1820 census Bosier appears for Bozarth, Bowman for Bannon, Edges for Hedges; in the 1830 census Clowder for Crowder, Rial for Royal; and in the 1840 census Dorathy for Daugherty, and Ivens for Evans. I have identified many of these, more foreign variations, however, there may be others, especially involving rarer names, that I have failed to detect and link to the proper version of that family name.
3. Though it would appear that one recorder would consistently spell a given name in the same manner this is not always the case. Sometimes the same writer in the same record spelled one family name in more than one way. Such as: Bryan - Bryant (1810 census), Wallace - Wallis (1810 census), Fulkinson - Phulkinson (1820 census), and Haynes -Heins (1820 census).
4. Occasionally a record taker confused a family name with another similar sounding name of a family also residing in the county. For example in the 1810 census Pardon Tabor appears as Pardon Taylor, in the 1820 census Fielding Southard is listed as Fielding Sutton, in the same census Benjamin Gray is Benjamin Grayer (Grayer is a common variation for the name Greer), in the 1840 census William S. Jones appears as William S. James and Stephen Stephenson as Stephen Stevens.
5. First names of individuals can also be quite varied. The same individual may be called by his first name one time, by a middle name the next, by a nickname in yet another, and initials may also occur for him, John Willis Black appears as Willis J. in the 1840 census but is J. W. in the 1830. John Gatewood Nall is Gatewood in the 1830 census and in the 1840 is John G. Sometimes a similar but different first name was substituted. For example: Lewis Ambrose, Sr. is listed as Landwick Ambrose in the 1820 census, in the same census Ancil Hall is Anson, Barnett Claunch is Barnard; in the 1840 census Josiah Maddox is Joseph and Reuben A. Miller is Richard A.
6. The same individual may be repeated twice in the same census. For example the same John Irvin appears twice in the 1810 census, in the 1820 census Thomas Baird and John Wakeland are listed twice, and in the 1840 census Lewis Ambrose, Jr. has been counted twice by the census taker.
7. In the index under one individual name more than one individual may be referred to. Middle names and initials were used when identified and validated to distinguish individuals of the same first and last name. For example in addition to

the separate listings for John Alexander Taylor and John Peyton Taylor, under the singular listing of John Taylor there are at least two if not more additional John Taylors that I could not breakdown into separate listings for each respective individual John Taylor.

8. When "Jr." & "Sr." appear in the original records or in the index do not assume they indicate a father - son relationship. Most of the time they do but in some instances they were used only to indicate that one individual was junior in years to another of the same name also living in the county. For example Joseph Barnett, Jr. (1798-1860) in the 1820 census is not the son of the elder Joseph Barnett (1777-1823), who is his uncle, but is the son of Robert Barnett.
