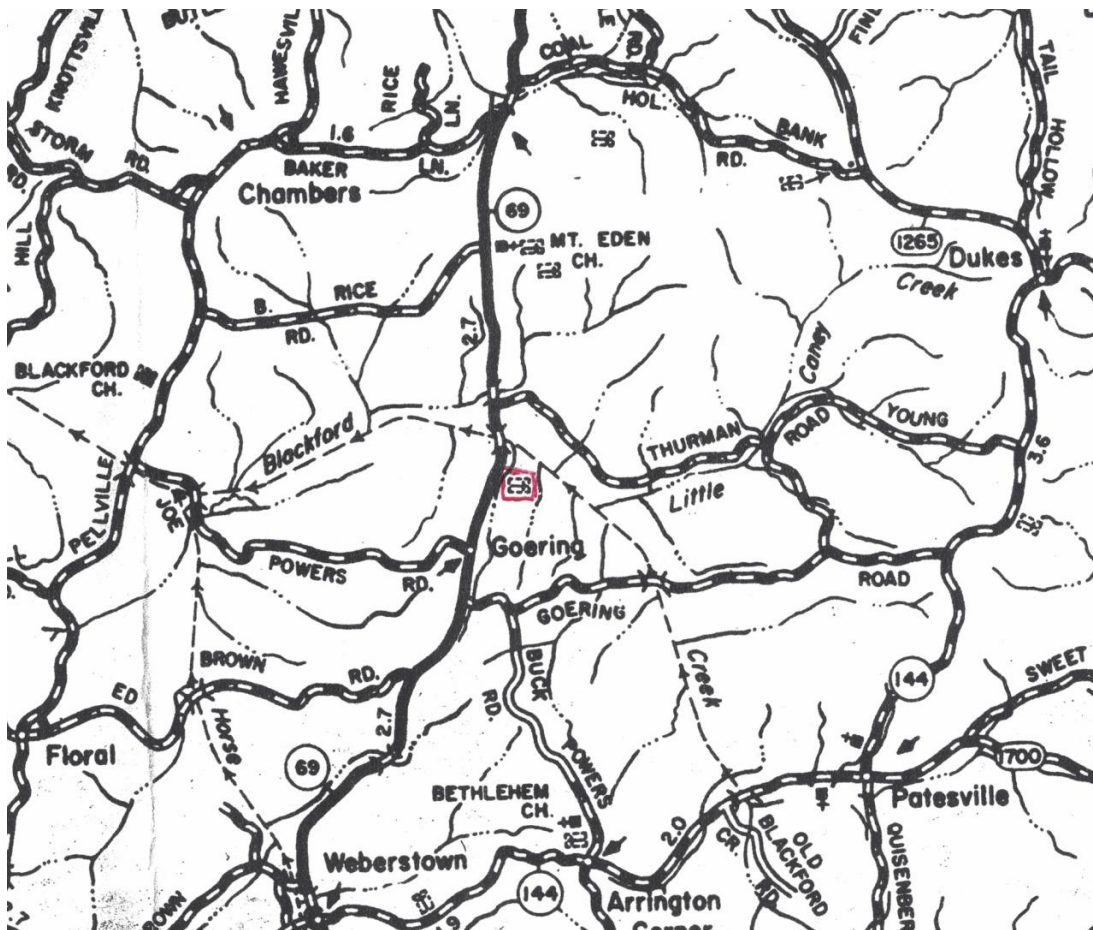


Powers Cemetery Hancock County, KY

Off of Highway 69 on hill just south of the Truman Young Road, about five miles south of Hawesville, Ky. Turn east off 69 into 2nd lane past the Young Road. Stop at top of hill and walk north about 50 feet. Cemetery is in edge of woods on north side of field. Inscriptions on monuments were copied by Jerry long on 24 October 1986. On five death certificates the cemetery was referred to as the Powers graveyard, on one other death record it was called the Nugent graveyard and on another the Stevens graveyard. The last known burial in the cemetery was Lucinda Catherine Stevens / Stephens, who died 9 August 1940. Her death certificate and obituary (Hancock Clarion Hawesville, KY, 16 Aug 1940 p1) reported she was buried at the Stevens burial ground near the Mt. Eden Church. She was the wife of Jesse Lee Stephens (married 3 Jan 1884 Hancock County, KY) and was the daughter of Hiram M. Nugent & Amelia Williams.
