Patton Family of Ohio County, KY

The following family record had been in the bible of Viola H. (Patton) Chapman (1886-1965), a native of Ohio County, KY. Viola was the daughter of Granville Hord Patton (1856-1943) & Melissa J. Hudson, granddaughter of Granville Patton (1822-1856) & Agnes Hord Bell, and great-granddaughter of John William Patton (1799-1859) & Henrietta Hudson. Viola Chapman late in life gave the bible to her first cousin, Ernest James Patton (1888-1969), son of James Thomas Patton (1854-1931) & Sallie M. French. Upon the death of Ernest the bible descended to his son, Clyde Patton (1914-1990). This writer interviewed, Clyde Patton on 25 November 1984. The bible subsequently went to Clyde's son, Tommy Patton, of Dallas, TX. In the following transcription of the bible record information in brackets are annotations added by Jerry Long.

Outline of Patton family of Ohio County, KY By Jerry Long

In the biographies of two grandsons of John Patton (born 1 May 1771) in the book, <u>Kentucky: A History of the State</u> (1885) it is stated that John was a native of Virginia and he and his wife, Delilah Vance, came to Kentucky in 1800, and settled in Allen County, where they resided until their deaths. John is listed in the 1810 census of Warren County, KY; he was residing in the part of Warren County that became Allen County upon its formation in 1815. He is listed in the 1820, 1830, 1840 & 1850 censuses of Allen County, KY.

John Patton died in 1856. He wrote his will on 14 July 1855 and it was recorded in Allen County, KY on 10 November 1856. He left to his wife, Delila Patton, his entire estate during her life. At her death it was to be left to his children, who were named as – Lucy Sears, Mary Belle, Nancy Oliver, John Patton, James Patton, Berry Patton, Granville Patton and Thornton Patton. "My son William Patton is not named as he has already had his full share." He appointed his wife the executor of his estate.

John Patton's wife, Delilah (Vance), was born 23 April 1792 and died in Allen County, KY in December 1859. The following marriages of John & Delilah's children were recorded in Allen County, KY – Lucy (born c1797) to Henry Sears, 1 May 1820; William (born 8 June 1793) to Lettie Spilman, 6 October 1818; Mary (born c1807) to Jefferson Bell, 23 August 1845; and Berry (born c1811) to Amanda J. Spears). Also in the early marriages of Allen County were the following marriages – Hugh Patton to Rebecca Johnson, 27 July 1818; Robert Patton to Nancy Atwood, 4 October 1819; and Susanna Patton to Lemuel Pace, 7 December 1818.

Three of the children of John Patton & Delilah Vance moved to Ohio County, KY – John W. Patton (1799-1859), Thornton (1805-1884) and Mary Patton (c1807-after 1856, wife of Jefferson Bell). Mary & Jefferson Bell (1800-1852) are listed in the 1850 census of Ohio County. Nancy Patton, a granddaughter of John & Delilah also made Ohio County her home. Nancy (1822-1886), daughter of William Patton & Lettie Spilman, married David Henry French in Allen County, KY on 9 January 1851. Nancy is listed in the 1860, 1870 & 1880 censuses of Ohio County, Nancy French died on 8 June 1886 and was buried at the Mt. Carmel Baptist Church Cemetery, in Ohio County, KY.

In the biography of Dr. John William Patton (1835-1908) in the book, <u>Kentucky: A</u> <u>History of the State</u> (1885, Ohio County section) it is stated that "In 1830 Thornton Patton came to Ohio County, and engaged in the distilling business with his brother, John Patton."

Thornton Patton, son of John & Delilah Patton, was born 5 August 1805 in Allen County, KY. He is listed in the 1840, 1850, 1860, 1870 & 1880 censuses of Ohio County, KY. In Ohio

County, KY on 5 August 1833 Thornton married Rebecca Jones, The daughter of James Jones & Sallie Sims, she was born 18 June 1809 and died 29 January 1882 Ohio County, KY. Thornton Patton died at the home of his son, Thornton Jasper Patton, near Hartford, in Ohio County, KY on 30 December 1884. Thornton & Rebecca were buried at the Barnett's Creek Baptist Church in Ohio County, KY.

PATTON.-At the residence of his son, T, J. Patton, near Hartford, Monday night, Dec. 29th, 1884, Thornton Patton, in the 80th year of his age. His remains were interred at Barnett's creek church on Wednesday morning. The deceased was the father of Mr. R. A. Patton, of this place. Kentucky: A History of the State (J. H. Battle, W. H. Perrin & G. C. Kniffin, 18885, Ohio County section):

DR. JOHN WILLIAM PATTON was born December 23, 1835, in Daviess County, Ky., and is the eldest of ten children born to Thornton and Rebecca (Jones) Patton, both natives of Virginia. Thornton Patton, in 1805, the year of his birth, was brought to Kentucky, by his parents, John and Delilah (Vance) Patton, who settled in Allen County, where they resided until their death. In 1830 Thornton Patton came to Ohio County, and engaged in the distilling business with his brother, John Patton. Here he married the daughter of James and Sallie (Sims) Jones, and soon after removed to Indiana; returning, settled in Ohio County where he died. At seventeen. Dr. J. W. Patton began working at the wheelwright trade, which he continued until his marriage with Malinda Hoover, December 7, 1859. He then engaged in farming and rafting on Rough Creek and Green River, at which he lost his health. He then studied medicine and managed the farm. He took a course of lectures at Louisville University and graduated in 1875, and practiced and farmed since. In business matters he has been very successful, having by personal efforts acquired a fine farm of 237 acres and other valuable property. Dr. and Mrs. Patton have six children living: Cicero M., Sarah F., James L., Mary A., Delilah A. and Clayton A. The Doctor is a Baptist and in politics a Democrat.

JAMES H. PATTON was born February 22, 1839, in this county, and is the third of a family of ten children born to Thornton and Rebecca (Jones) Patton. The father was born in Allen County, Ky., a son of John Patton, a native of Virginia, who came to Kentucky in 1800. The mother, when eleven years old, came with her father, James Jones' family to Kentucky; she died January 28, 1882, and her husband December 30, 1884. They were members of the United Baptist Church. Our subject has been a farmer since boyhood. When of age he worked out by the month, and worked for others for some nine years. With his earnings he bought a small farm which he improved, then sold out and bought his present farm consisting of eighty acres of fertile land, principally under cultivation. He was married to Miss Lucy C. Coleman, October 27, 1870, daughter of Frank and Sarah E. (Bennett) Coleman, of Ohio County. By this union they have one child — Ada R. Mr. Patton is a Mason, and in politics a Democrat. His wife is a Methodist.

They were the parents of – Cicero Maxwell (1859-1939, married Martha Susan Wade & Emma Susan Midkiff), Sarah Frances (1861-1927, married Thomas Peyton Ralph), James Lewis (1864-1927, Ohio County Judge shot & killed by James Johnston at the Ohio County Courthouse), Mary Ann (1867-1958, single), Martha Ann (1867-1867), Delilah Artimissa (1870-1899, married Henry Wise Ralph) and Clayton Lunsford (1880-1955, married Mrs. Lena R. Miller Acton).

- Chillis Berry Patton, born 26 July 1838 Ohio County, KY; married Nancy Elvira Funk (born 22 May 1850 Butler County, KY, daughter of Thomas H. Funk & Frances Fields), 1 May 1867 Ohio County, KY; Chillis died 15 August 1874; his widow, Nancy, married William Mann, 23 March 1875 Ohio County, KY, she died 4 December 1889 and was buried at the Barnett's Creek Baptist Church Cemetery, Ohio County, KY. Chillis & Nancy were the parents of – Elijah Luellen (1868-1953, married Susan Frances Taylor) and Fannie R. (1872-1948, married James William Stewart & Wesley Alonzo Allen).
- James H. Patton, born 22 February 1839 Ohio County, KY; married Lucy C. Coleman (16 June 1853 Ohio County, KY – 12 June 1922 Hartford, Ohio County, KY, daughter of John Franklin Coleman & Sarah E. Bennett), 27 October 1870 Ohio County, KY; James died at Hartford, Ohio County, KY on 3 November 1928; he and Lucy were buried at Oakwood Cemetery, Hartford, Ohio County, KY. They were parents of – Ona E. (1873-1874), Ada R. (1875-1969, married William H. Barnes) and Annie J. (1887-1930, married Dr. Charles Ross Bennett).
- Richard Albert Patton, born c1840 Ohio County, KY; married Sarah E. Bennett (19 June 1837 No Creek, Ohio County, KY – 15 May 1903 Hartford, Ohio County, KY, buried Carson Cemetery, No Creek, Ohio County, KY, daughter of Joseph B. Bennett & Sarah Carson). He & Sarah were divorced during 1880-1890; they had no children. Sarah married 4 times in Ohio County, KY, John Franklin Coleman, 6 December 1852, John W. Stevens, 6 August 1860, Richard A. Patton, 3 January 1867, and Lewis Frederick Woerner, 20 January 1891. Richard A. Patton married Mrs. Martha Elizabeth (Kimbrell) Culpepper (15 July 1852 – 27 August 1908), 10 February 1887 Bibb County, GA. Richard A. died 3 May 1918 Macon, Bibb County, GA and was buried Rose Hill Cemetery, Macon, GA. By his 2nd wife, Martha, he had a daughter – Lila Mildred (1888-1980, married Lucius David Selman).
- 5. Mary A. Patton, born 5 June 1842 Ohio County, KY; married Jesse Blackman Moseley (12 December 1832 Ohio County, KY 12 January 1889 Ohio County, KY, son of Robert P. Mosley, Jr. & Mary Ann Allen, he had previously married Mary Jane Taylor & Sarah Emiline Leach, he was buried Brick House Cemetery, Ohio County, KY), 27 October 1885 Ohio County, KY. She appears to have been living in 1908 when her brother, John W. Patton, died; his obit says he was survived by 4 sisters & 4 brothers.
- 6. Thornton Jasper Patton, born 4 January 1844 Ohio County, KY; married Isabella Buckner Hudson (1 April 1862 Ohio County, KY 27 March 1928 Owensboro, Daviess County, KY, daughter of Robert Hudson & Mary Willis Bell), 12 March 1882 Ohio County, KY; Thornton died 16 May 1925 McLean County, KY; he & his wife were buried Oak Hill Cemetery, Livermore, McLean County, KY. They were parents of Leota (1883-1968, married Noble Eugene Dodson), Lumeta (1884-1925, single), Jessie Frances (1890-1926, married Noel Allison Malin) and one other child died infancy.
- Nathaniel Granville Patton, born 5 December 1845 Ohio County, KY; married Martha Washington Tinsley (14 October 1851 Ohio County, KY – 7 December 1924 Ohio County, KY, daughter of Joseph Tinsley & Susan Sledd), 22 August 1869 Ohio County, KY; he died 18 March 1916 Ohio County, KY; he & his wife were buried Concord

Cemetery, Ohio County, KY. They were parents of – James William (1872-1957, married Mrs. Dorcas May Snell Gray), Samuel P. (1874-1904, married Ida Leach), Chellis Berry (1877-1922, married Carrie Hoover), Joseph Thornton (1878-1942, married Ada Gustava Sheffield), Herbert Jasper (1881-19160, married Ida Leach), Sarah Isabelle (1883-1952, married Albert Urise Austin), Fred Granville (1885-1931, married Elizabeth Florence Allen), Mary Ann (1887-1950, married William Alec Rush & Martin Augustus Foltz), Lucy Clara Frances (1892-1962, married John Thomas Midkiff) and one other died childhood.

- 8. Delilah E. Patton, born 29 March 1848 Ohio County, KY; died single 11 October 1935 Evansville, Vanderburgh County, IN, where she was buried at the St. Joseph Cemetery.
- 9. Lucy Ophelia Patton, born 27 December 1849 Ohio County, KY; married Jesse N. Hudson (18 July 1835 Ohio County, KY 20 October 1923 Beda, Ohio County, Y, son of Henry Hudson), 28 January 1874 Ohio County, KY, they were divorced 1874, Lucy married 2nd Robert Levi Nelson (10 September 1862 28 October 1926 Vanderburgh County, IN, son of Rev. Joshua Palmer Nelson & Sarah Jane Edge, buried McCord Cemetery, Ohio County, KY), 1 December 1881 Ohio County, KY; Lucy died 8 June 1926 Evansville, Vanderburgh County, IN, she was buried Barnett's Creek Baptist Church Cemetery, Ohio County, KY. She had two children Arthur Nelson (1884-1946, married May Brown) and one died prior to 1900.
- Mahala Frances Patton, born 21 September 1852 Ohio County, KY; married William H. Dawson (11 December 1840 – 28 February 1880 Ohio County, KY, son of Jackson Dawson & Bethena Bishop, buried Barnett's Creek Baptist Church Cemetery, Ohio County, KY), 7 December 1871 Ohio County, KY and Allen King, Jr. (31 March 1853 Ohio County, KY – 20 February 1928 Ohio County, KY, son of Allen King & Margaret Cooper, buried Oakwood Cemetery, Hartford, Ohio County, KY), 30 March 1882 Ohio County, KY. Mahala died 11 January 1920 Ohio County, KY and was buried Barnett's Creek Baptist Church Cemetery, Ohio County, KY. She was the mother of two children – William Jasper Dawson (1873-1930, married Allie May) & James Hyman Dawson (1878-1939, married Susan Emma Sharp).

John William Patton, son of John Patton & Delilah Vance, was born 1 March 1799 Virginia; he was an infant of less than two years when his parents settled in Allen County, KY. In 1830 he and his brother, Thornton, moved to Ohio County, KY. John is listed in the 1830 & 1840 censuses of Ohio County, KY. He married Henrietta Hudson in Ohio County, KY on 29 August 1821. The daughter of Thomas & Susannah Hudson, she was born 19 June 1803 and died in September 1841. John and four of his children appear in the 1850 census of Allen County, KY (initials were used for his children, Lucy R., James R., Mary C. & Joshua J.). He was reported to be a farmer and was enumerated immediately after the household of his parents, John & Delilah Patton. John Patton, Jr. died in 1859. In Ohio County, KY Thomas Patton was appointed administrator of his father, John Patton's estate on 18 July 1859.

Family bible records and Ohio County Circuit Court suit #1575 (petition in 1865 for sale of lands of Thomas Hudson deceased) show that John Patton, Jr. & Henrietta Hudson were the parents of the following seven children:

On 9 March 1985 this writer (Jerry Long) visited (Miss) Mary Arnold Patton (1907-1988) at her home, 1219 Western Court, in Owensboro, KY. We were 2nd cousins twice removed through the Pate family – her grandmother Sallie Mary (Pate) Patton was a sister to my greatgreat-grandmother, Elizabeth Jane (Pate) Taylor. Miss Patton was the daughter of Luther Mason Patton (1869-1945) & Lona Ella May, granddaughter of John Robert Patton (1832-1889) &

Sallie Mary Pate, great-granddaughter of John William Patton (1799-1859) & Henrietta Hudson, and great-great-granddaughter of John Patton (1771-1856) & Delilah Vance.

Mary Patton knew a lot about her family and helped in filling in connections to the Patton family of my Pate and Taylor ancestral lines. She allowed me to make copies of several pictures she had of the children of John Robert Patton & Sallie Mary Pate.

Mary Arnold Patton had no immediate relatives when she died in 1988. Her family pictures and papers were given to her neighbor, Lizzie Mae Freitag, who subsequently gave them to her sister, Lorena Simpson. Later when Mrs. Simpson was looking for a home for the items they were claimed by Shirley Timbrook, an Owensboro genealogy enthusiast. Shirley was a frequent visitor to the Kentucky Room at the Daviess County Public Library in Owensboro, where I was an employee. When Miss Timbrook learned of my family connection she gave me the family items of the late Mary Arnold Patton on 16 September 1991.



Sir Mrs. Frank L. Pate died near my house on the Newburg Road on the Ohio River in Daviess County 12 miles below Owensboro on the 29th day of July present of Dropsy. She had twin infants which are at my house now one of them I think will die in a few days. Frank died also today leaving five children besides the twins. They are scrattered around among the neighbors. Frank asked me to write to you saying that you married his sister and say that he wanted you to come and get the children and let the other relatives know of his death & c. You will confer a favor by coming at once as I have a large family and cant keep the children. Address me as this letter is headed. Respectfully, N. M. Newman


Preceding letter was written by Nathaniel M. Newman (1834-1917) of Grissom's Landing, Daviess County, KY to John Robert Patton (1832-1889, husband of Sallie Mary Pate, of Pleasant Ridge, Daviess County, KY, informing him of the deaths of Francis L. Pate (c1838-1880) & his wife, Lucy Hudson (c1843-1880). Francis L. Pate and Sallie Mary (Pate) Patton were children of William Pate & his first wife, Rebecca Midkiff. Francis L. & Lucy Pate and five children, Ida B., Bedford F., William L., Henry M. and James A. are listed in the Oakford Precinct in the 1880 census of Daviess County, near the residence of Nathaniel M. Newman.
