President Abraham Lincoln issued the Emancipation Proclamation on 1 January 1863. The proclamation declared "that all persons held as slaves" within the rebellious states "are, and henceforward shall be free." The nation was then approaching its third year of bloody civil war that had been spurred by the conflict over slavery. "States Rights" had become a critical and paramount issue due to the issue of slavery. Slavery was abolished when the 13th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution was passed by Congress on 31 January 1865 and ratified by the States on 6 December 1865.



Ohio County, KY 1850 Federal Census – free blacks

The first federal census to enumerate Blacks was the 1870 census. Prior to Emancipation only a handful of "free blacks" were included in the 1850 and 1860 census reports. Below is a listing of the Blacks who were recorded in the 1850 federal census of Ohio County, KY.

Ohio County, KY 1850 Slave Schedule – slave owners

During the 1850 United States Federal Census, enslaved individuals were recorded separately in what were called slave schedules. They enumerated the slaves under their slave owners’ name. They give the slaves age, sex, and whether Black or mulatto. Most schedules do not give the slaves’ name. Upon Emancipation not all of the slaves listed in the slave schedules took their master’s surname but many did.

The 1850 Ohio County, KY Slave Schedule suggests there were approximately 1,500 slaves in the county. The 1860 Ohio County, KY Slave Schedule records about 1,700 slaves. Ohio County, KY 1860 Federal Census Mortality Schedule

The US Federal Censuses of 1860 & 1870 included a mortality schedule enumerating the individuals who had died in the previous year. They recorded the deaths that occurred in the county from June 1 of the previous year until May 31 of the census year. For example the 1860 mortality schedule listed the deaths between 1 June 1859 and 31 May 1860. Some of the entries list the slave with a last name but the majority simply recorded the individual as “slave of...” The original

records were alphabetized in the following list by the last name (if given) or by the first name in the “slave of” entries.

Ohio County, KY 1870 Tax List – list of negroes

The first time the freed slaves were listed in the annual tax lists of Ohio County was in the year 1868. The 1867 tax book for the county is missing. In the 1868 tax list and for many years to come Blacks appeared in the Ohio County tax books in a separate listing labeled: “Negroes”. In these records only males over the age of 21 or any others owning land were named. Two pages of the microfilm copy of the 1868 and one page of the 1869 Negroes tax lists are blurred and could not be fully deciphered.

Below is a listing of the Negroes in the 1870 Ohio County tax book. If they owned any land the number of acres and its water course are noted. The list also contained a category of children between 6 and 20 years old.

[note – Kibby Jo Hocker (1792-1881) was a Methodist minister for over 40 years and married many Ohio County couples].

In slavery, African Americans could not legally marry. Although many slaves had lived as husband and wife, their marriages had no legal status. After Emancipation, freed people wanted to make their marriages legal, and many applied to the state for marriage licenses. In many states after Emancipation any couple who appeared before a Justice of the Peace or Clerk of the Court and stated when they began living together as husband and wife, would be issued a certificate and would be considered lawfully married. Freedmen’s Bureau officers worked to make all freedmen in their districts aware of the new rules and of the deadlines for complying with them. In response, tens of thousands of freed couples reported their marriages to county courts.

In Ohio County 45 couples registered their marriages. They were recorded in a book entitled: “Freedmen’s Declaration of Marriage”, also labeled as – Book L. On the preceding page is a copy of the standardized form that was utilized. Recorded were the names of the couple, the number of years they had been living together as husband and wife and the date of the registration of their marriage. The longest time a couple had been together was 38 years – which suggests they had jumped the broom about 1828.

COMMENTS

The first register of Black concurrent marriages in Ohio County is labeled Negro Marriage Register M (1866-1883). Recorded in this volume are the names of the groom & bride, date of license, date of marriage, witnesses to the marriage and the celebrant of the ceremony. In the following list of the 1866-1870 marriages in this volume the date of the marriage is listed. Most couples were not married on the date they had obtained their license. The master index of the county's marriages records the date the license was issued not the marriage date. Thus the marriage date that frequently appears on genealogy sites is the couples license date not the actual date of

their marriage. The first marriage licenses granted to Blacks recorded in Ohio County was on 15 March 1866. On this day two couples were issued licenses – Alfred Morton to Letha Ann Taylor and Richard Taylor to Mary F. Bell.
