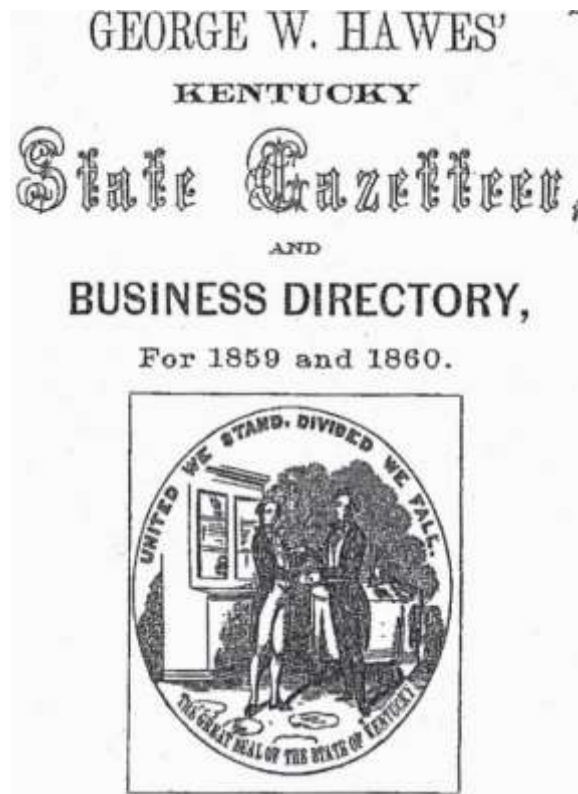

OWENSBORO

A thriving post village, and the capital of Daviess county, situated on the Ohio River, 9 miles below Rockport, and 155 miles below Louisville, fare \$3; 180 miles west south-west from Frankfort, fare \$2.50; 15 from Knottsville, 16 from Whitesville, 62 from Greenville, 50 from Madisonville, 9 from Oakford, 90 from Russelville, fare \$6; 60 from Shawneetown, fare \$4.50; and 100 from Louisville, fare \$6.

It is situated in a very very fertile region, abounding in mineral resources, and is the principal shipping port of the county, commanding an active interior trade.

In addition to the usual county buildings, it contains six churches, (one Catholic, four American Protestant, and one African), St. Francis Academy, a Catholic institution, a female high school, and two select schools, two weekly newspapers, (the *National Democrat*, published every Wednesday, by J. P. Washum, and the *National American*, every Saturday, by J. G. Ford), two Masonic Lodges, and one Chapter, one Lodge I. O. O. F., No, 130, one Temple of Honor, one bank, (Branch of the Southern Bank of Kentucky), one steam flouring and saw mill, one carding machine, three hotels, about forty stores and warehouses of various kinds, several tobacco stemmeries, ten physicians and surgeons, eight attorneys, two magistrates, one beef and pork packer, two brickyards, two brewers, four engravers, one foundery and machine shop, one tanner, three jewelers, one marble yard, two milliners, and a great variety of mechanical trades. Population 8,000. J. H. Higdon, Postmaster.

Owensboro Directory, 1871-72.

Owensboro is situated on the Ohio river, 160 miles below Louisville, is built upon a large and level tract, with but a few slight undulations, and is entirely above the reach of the highest overflows. In point of population it is excelled by no city on the river, from the falls of the Ohio to Cairo, excepting Evansville and Paducah, and is rapidly growing in population and material wealth. It is surrounded by a body of land extending from its limits for many miles east, west and south, of remarkable fertility and productiveness, large quantities of which are cleared and cultivated by enterprising, intelligent and thrifty farmers and the uncultivated parts abound in all varieties of the finest timber.

Tobacco is one of the staples of Daviess and adjacent counties, large quantities of which, of superior quality, are annually produced, for which planters find a convenient market at Owensboro, where the most remunerative prices are readily realized.

The corn crop yields from ten to twenty barrels per acre, and the return of small grain is usually excellent. Grasses of all kinds flourish, and as the change in the labor system will necessarily discourage the past laborious process of agriculture, this section of the country will encounter no difficulty in successfully competing with the stock raisers of the Blue Grass region. The prejudice long existing in older portions of the State, that the Green river country is unhealthy, is rapidly wearing away, since the reasons from which it sprung have almost ceased to exist. Statistics, no doubt, would show that diseases prevail here to no greater extent, and certainly mortality is not greater than in sections whose healthfulness is unquestioned. There has been a change in this respect, and it is undoubtedly attributable to the clearing up and permitting the sun to shine on the lands once shaded by dense forests from his salubrious beams.

Owensboro has always been so much a commercial place, that much less has been expended in improvements, and many of those made are less imposing, than those of other cities of less business importance and wealth. Many handsome residences, however, have been erected, some of which approach palatial magnificence. Twelve establishments, devoted exclusively to the purchasing, prizing, &c., of tobacco, find ample scope for their operations, and among them several millions of pounds are annually purchased and re-sold in domestic and foreign markets.

Public attention has - but recently been turned to manufactures, yet we already note two planing mills, one of which — owned by Messrs. Byrom, Marble & Co. — is the most extensive in the West. This firm have in their yards about \$90,000 worth of assorted seasoned pine and poplar lumber, and they give employment to about one hundred hands. They furnish doors, sash, &c., as cheap as they can be furnished in Philadelphia or New York. We have one largw Woolen Mill and Foundry; two Broom Factories, two extensive Breweries, a Furniture Factory, Carriage Factory, Barrel Factory, Spoke and Hub Factory - Pin Factory, Edge Tool Factory, and Stove Foundry in course of erection. Distilleries, saw and grist mills are numerous and flourishing, affording employment to hundreds of laborers.

Timber for manufacturing purposes is to be found in the greatest abundance, and of every quality and variety.

Coal, equal to the best Pittsburgh, is abundant, and can be delivered at ten cents per bushel.

Iron, equal to that produced by the Sligo works, in Tennessee, or the Sweed or Norway iron, can be produced from the ore to be found in the greatest abundance in the hills of McLean, Muhlenburg and Daviess counties.

Railroads and Steamboats.

We have a daily line of the finest steamers on the western waters plying between this city and Louisville, and Judge Weir, president of the Owensboro and Russellville Railroad, is sanguine of the early completion of his road to the Tennessee line. This road will place us in direct communication with the entire South, and active preparations are being made to form a connection with this road North, connecting us, North of the Ohio river, by rail, with the Mobile and Ohio Railroad, thus giving us direct communication with all the northern cities. In addition to this, a project is now on foot to construct a railroad from Chicago, intersecting the Owensboro and Russellville Railroad at this point, connecting us by rail with Chicago and Pensacola, Florida.

The Owensboro and Russellville Railroad will pass through a country inhabited by a thriving population, inexhaustible in the amount of its excellent timber, and abounding in coal and other mineral resources, it is confidently predicted that its construction will be the means of inaugurating an era of prosperity unexampled in its history.

Reasoning from the innumerable advantages she possesses, it seems not too much to prophecy that Owensboro will outstrip the foremost of her sister towns in Southern Kentucky, with the same facility that she sprang in the past from a small, modest town to a flourishing and enterprising young city of ten thousand inhabitants.

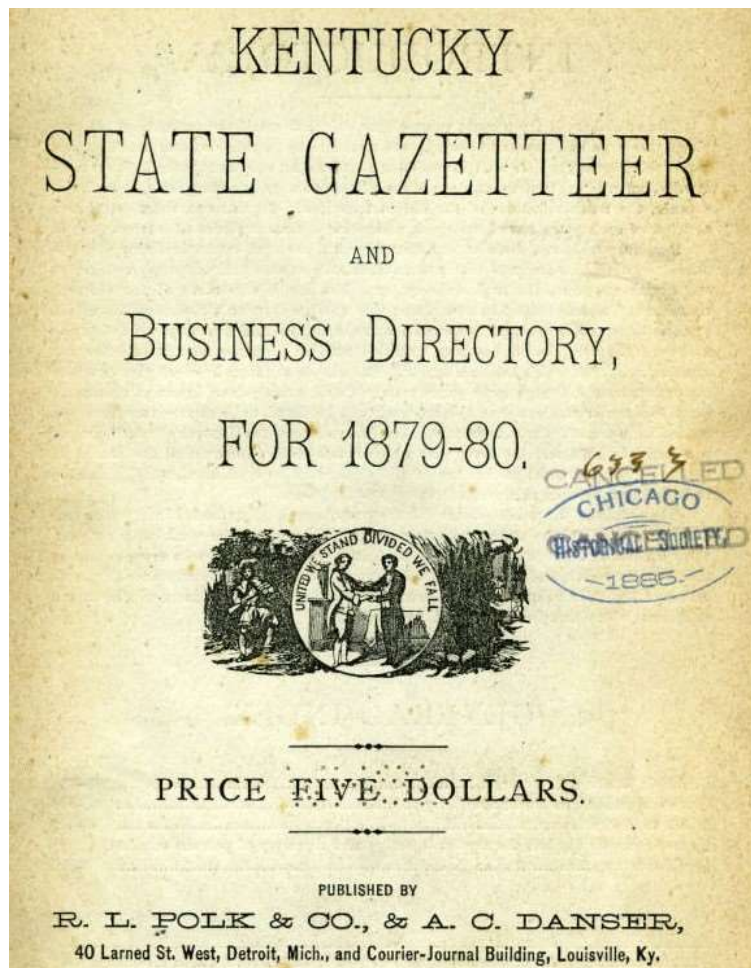

This beautiful and enterprising city of 6,000 inhabitants is on the Ohio river, the county seat of Daviess county, and the metropolis of an extremely fertile country, devoted principally to the culture of tobacco. It is 40 miles above Evansville, Ind., on the line of the E., O. & N. R. R., now discontinued. Owensboro junction, 86 ¼ miles south, on the P. & E. R. R., is its nearest shipping point by rail. Twenty-three tobacco stemmeries are located here, which annually export 15,000,000 pounds of tobacco. Large deposits of coal underlie this region of country. There are several handsome private residences and public buildings in the place, among the latter being the courthouse and public school building. It also has 14 churches of various denominations, four banks, and two weekly newspapers. The streets are lighted with gas, and the town is well protected from fire by a well organized fire company. A private corporation has contracted to give the city an ample supply of water under the Holly system. This enterprise is estimated to cost \$137,000, and will be completed without cost to the city.
