

Blacks in Hancock County, KY Records Before 1880

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President Abraham Lincoln issued the Emancipation Proclamation on 1 January 1863. The proclamation declared "that all persons held as slaves" within the rebellious states "are, and henceforward shall be free." The nation was then approaching its third year of bloody civil war that had been spurred by the conflict over slavery. "States Rights" had become a critical and paramount issue due to the issue of slavery. Slavery was abolished when the 13th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution was passed by Congress on 31 January 1865 and ratified by the States on 6 December 1865.

Hancock County, KY 1850 Federal Census – free Blacks

The first federal census to enumerate Blacks was the 1870 census. Prior to Emancipation only a handful of "free blacks" were included in the 1850 and 1860 census reports. Below is a listing of the Blacks & Mulattos, who were recorded in the 1850 federal census of Hancock County, KY.

Hancock County, KY 1850 Slave Schedule – slave owners

In the United States Federal Censuses of 1850 and 1860 enslaved individuals were recorded separately in what were called slave schedules. The slaves were enumerated under their slave owners' name. The slave schedules record the slaves age, sex, and whether Black or Mulatto. The slave schedules have some value due to the fact that upon Emancipation many of the slaves took their master's surname and many of those enumerated were subsequent citizens of Hancock County.

The 1850 Hancock County, KY Slave Schedule suggests there were approximately 608 slaves in the county. The 1860 Hancock County, KY Slave Schedule records about 733 slaves. The 1850 & 1860 Hancock County, KY Slave Schedules may be viewed on the Internet sites Familysearch.org or Ancestry.com. The following are the slave owners and the number of slaves owned that are listed in the 1850 Hancock County, KY Slave Schedule; the original schedule enumerates the sex, age and whether Black or Mulatto of each of the slaves.

Hancock County, KY 1852-1861 Vital Statistics – births

During the years of 1852-1861 the state of Kentucky recorded some vital statistics (births, marriages & deaths). These records were filed in the state capitol, Frankfort, and copies were not kept in the counties. With the onset of the Civil War the record keeping on the state level ceased. Since slavery during these years was still enforce there were no marriages recorded for Blacks. The birth and death entries for Hancock County can be viewed on the websites Familysearch.org or Ancestry.com. The following are records of births of Blacks and Mulattos in Hancock County, KY. The names of their owners not their actual parents were recorded. In four years (1855, 1856, 1857, 1858) the mother's first name was listed.

They recorded the deaths that occurred in the county from June 1 of the previous year until May 31 of the census year. For example the 1860 mortality schedule listed the deaths between 1 June 1859 and 31 May 1860. The Hancock County, KY 1860 Mortality Schedule listed the following Blacks and Mulattos:

Hancock County, KY 1868 Tax List – list of Negroes

The first time the freed slaves were listed in the annual tax lists of Hancock County was in the year 1868. The 1867 tax book for the county is missing. In the 1868 tax list and for many years to come Blacks appeared in the Hancock County tax books in a separate listing labeled: “Negroes”. In these records only males over the age of 21 or any others owning land were named.

Below is a listing of the Negroes in the 1868 Hancock County tax book. If they owned any land the number of acres and its water course are noted. Only one Black (John Shaw) was reported to be a land owner. The list also contained a category of children between 6 and 20 years old.
