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## WPA's Registration of Veterans' Graves Hancock County, KY

When the Great Depression hit the United States in 1929, the American economy hit rock bottom. The value of the dollar became nearly worthless and millions of Americans lost their jobs. In 1933, President Franklin D. Roosevelt introduced "The New Deal," a series of new programs designed to pick America back up on to its feet and get the economy moving again. The Works Progress Administration (WPA), founded in 1935, was one of the federal work programs. The Graves Registration Program was one of several projects of the WPA. The purpose of this public project was to learn and record burial data on men who had served our country from the American Revolution through World War I. Some of this recorded information will not be found through any other sources.

These records were not comprehensive of all veterans' graves in Hancock County; they are only the ones identified by the WPA workers. Many names are misspelled and there is a high error rate in the dates cited. Several individuals are duplicated. The greatest value in this listing is possibly in the identification of the place of burial.

The original record may include – birth and death, cemetery where interred and cemetery's location. Many veterans of the Civil War are listed. Others listed were veterans of the Mexican War, Spanish American War and World War I; and others served during peace time.

Information between brackets are annotations not on original record – may include correction to name, birth & death year, when served and outfit served with if readily identified.

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The dedication of the Hancock County War Memorial on 14 August 1948 in Hawesville, KY. It stands in front of the (Old) Hancock County Courthouse. The memorial is of Georgia marble and

stands seven feet in height from a base of concrete, with wings to the right and to the left on which are engraved the names of those of the war dead from Hancock County of both World Wars – the one to the right being dedicated to those who gave their lives in World War I and that to the left of World War II.
